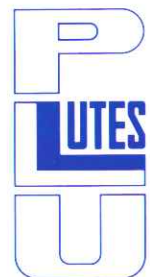
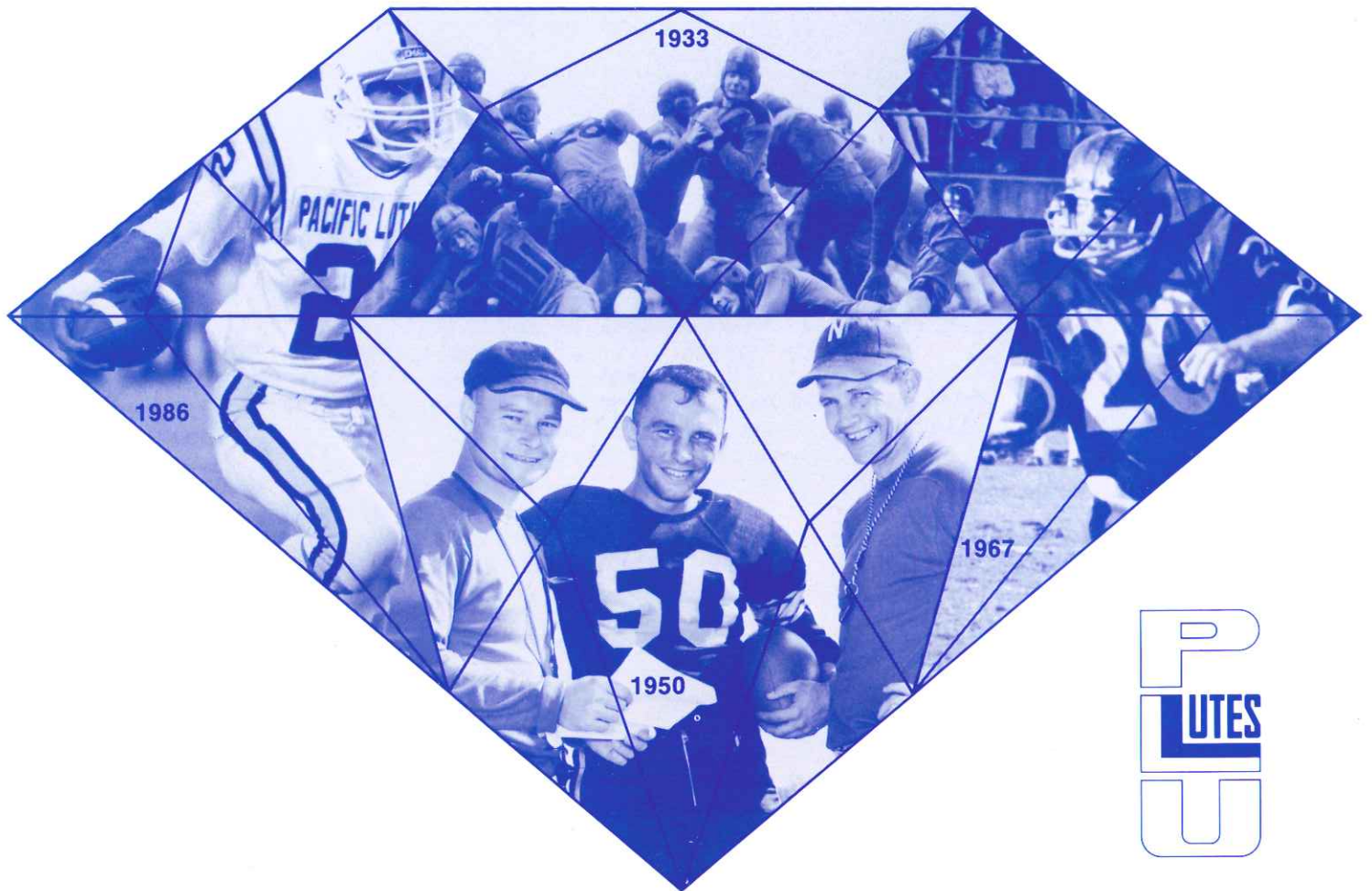

**JEFF GATES** — Senior End - One of six 1986 captains, Jeff is having a fine year at his left end position. He is third in receptions with 12 for 153 yards and a touchdown. A Business major, Jeff is a three-year veteran of Lute football.

**MIKE JOHNSON** — Senior End - Mike has seen limited action this season, with just one catch, a 57-yarder for a TD. A transfer from Yakima Valley CC, Mike had three receptions for 49 yards as a junior last season. A History major, he hails from Humtulpis, Washington.

### Pacific Lutheran vs. Western Washington, November 15, 1986

Lute Gridders will take the final step toward their sixth playoff appearance in eight years this afternoon when they clash with the Vikings of Western Washington. The Lutes lead in the all-time series with Western, 28-17-3, and have won the last eight meetings.

PLU, which clinched its second Columbia Football League Northern Division title in as many years last week in a 21-0 blanking of Simon Fraser, carries a 7-1 overall mark and a 5-0 divisional record into this afternoon's contest. Western, 2-6 and 1-4, fell 41-14 to Puget Sound last week.

"We're kind of looking at today's game as the first round of the playoffs," said Lute coach Frosty Westering. "If we don't win, our season's possibly over. Western is one of those hot-cold teams and they have some good people," he said. "Record-wise, they're not doing very well, but we think they're a good football team. Any team is a potentially competitive team in our minds," he said.

Western hasn't beaten the Lutes since 1976, a 48-28 victory in the District 1 playoffs. Last year, the Lutes pounded the Vikings 52-21 thanks to a record-tying performance by quarterback Jeff Yarnell. Yarnell threw four TD passes in the first half, five on the afternoon, joining Lute greats Marv Tommervik and Brad Westering in the PLU record books for most TDs thrown in a game.

Halfback Mike Vindivich had one of his finest performances of the season last week against Simon Fraser, rushing for 157 yards and catching six passes for 51 yards. He will be sidelined, however, for at least today's contest after sustaining severe lacerations to his left calf when he fell on the first-down chains. Defensive end Jon Kral also shined in Saturday's win, registering eight tackles and two quarterback sacks for minus-11 yards.

PLU, ranked fifth in the NAIA Division II football poll, is virtually guaranteed a berth in the 1986 football playoffs with a win this afternoon. Last season, the Lutes went 9-0-1 before falling to Wisconsin-LaCrosse 24-7 in the NAIA national championship game.
