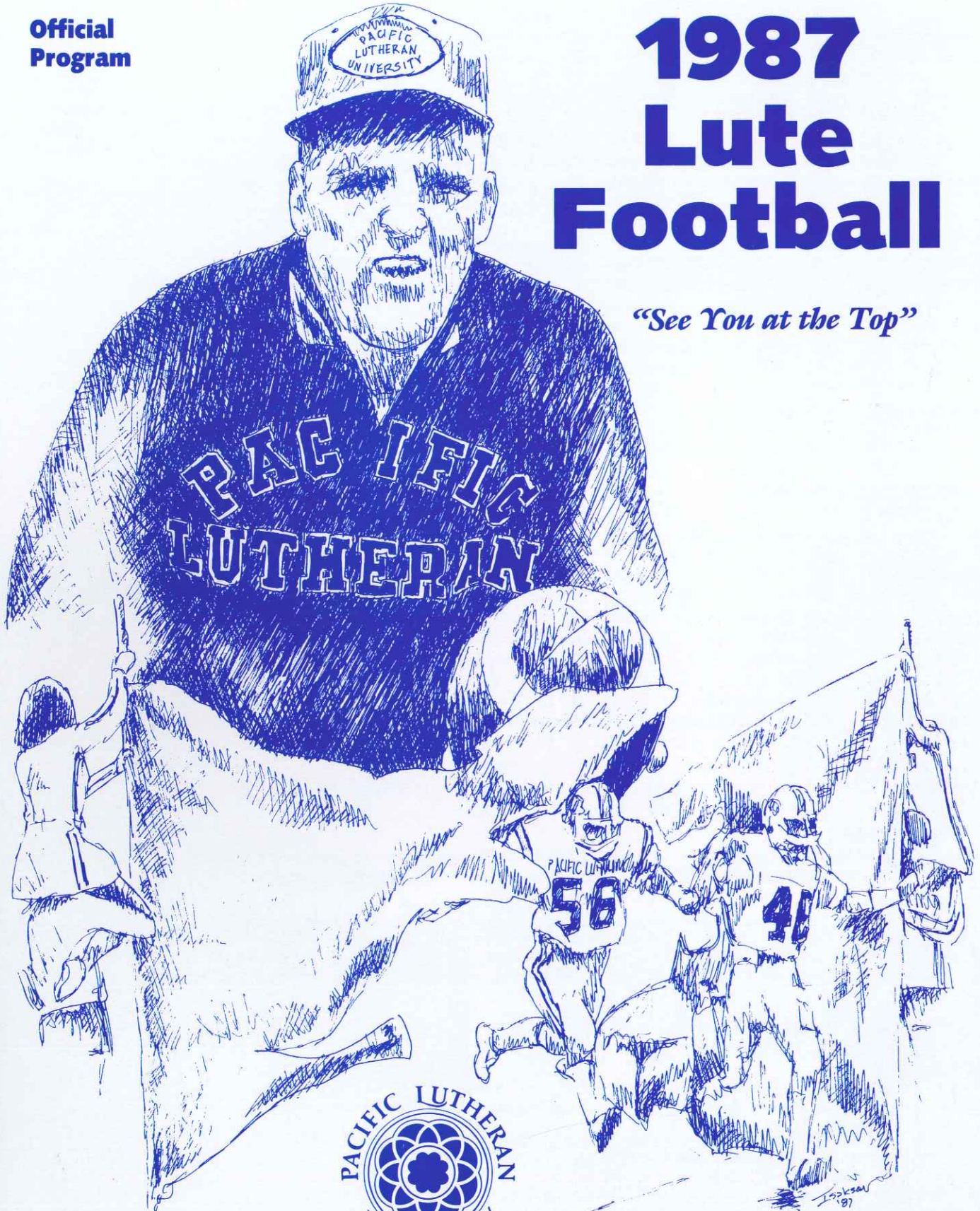

**SAM KURLE** — Senior Offensive Guard - One of two incumbents on PLU's relatively young offensive line, Sam is a four-year veteran of PLU football. A senior from Puyallup, he started at offensive tackle last season, but makes the switch to guard this year. Sam is a Computer Science major.



**STEVE VALACH** — Senior Running Back - Sidelined much of last year with injuries, Steve will likely be in on plenty of action in 1987. He opened the season last week against UPS with five receptions for 45 yards and PLU's lone TD, a ten-yarder from QB Jeff Yarnell. A senior from Salem, OR, Steve is a secondary education major.



**TODD MOSESON** — Senior Fullback - The leading returnee from last year in both rushing and receiving, Todd adds a degree of versatility to PLU's offensive attack. He rushed for 68 yards in the Lutes' loss to UPS, and also caught three passes for 36 yards. Today is the Puyallup senior's 23rd birthday.



**SCOTT SQUIRES** — Senior Linebacker - A part-timer last season, Scott is the middle-man in PLU's hard-hitting trio of starting linebackers in 1987. ## PLU vs. Oregon Tech, September 26, 1987

After absorbing their first season-opening loss in ten seasons, PLU coach Frosty Westering's Lute gridders will look to regroup this afternoon when they take on the Owls of Oregon Tech in a non-divisional match-up.

PLU, which yielded 314 yards on the ground to Puget Sound in Thursday's 24-7 season-opening setback, will likely see an about-face in offensive styles against Oregon Tech, the NAIA Division I's top passing team last year with a 337.0 average per game through the air.

"OIT is a fine football team. I think we'll have to be ready for land or air, though," said Westering, whose club last year turned back the Owls 28-22 at Lakewood Stadium. "They've got a lot of weapons in both their running and passing game which make them hard to defense," he said.

Despite their pre-season billing as the "Oregon Tech Air Force," it was the Owls' running game which propelled them to a 40-14 victory over Pacific last week. Senior RB Jerry Clay rushed for 207 yards on 19 carries and caught seven passes for 44 yards in the win. On the defensive side of the football, look for senior linebacker Joe Cain to be in on plenty of the action. Cain, an honorable mention All-America selection last year, led an Owl defense that held Pacific to minus-89 yards rushing last week with 13 tackles. Included in that yardage were 10 QB sacks for minus-107 yards.

Westering praised the performance of his three running backs in the season-opener to UPS. "I was pleased with the balance we showed in that phase of our offense," he said. "I also thought the play of our young offensive line, in general, was encouraging."

PLU has a 3-1 advantage in the all-time series with Oregon Tech, which began in 1981. PLU has won the last two meetings between the schools, 28-22 last year and 55-14 in 1985.
