



2022 PLAYER CODE OF CONDUCT

"Through teaching youth the game of softball and promoting good sportsmanship, teamwork, respect, and fair play, PVPGSL strives to inspire them and to enrich their lives toward their own adult responsibility in the communities in which they will be living."

As a player of Palos Verdes Peninsula Girls Softball League, I agree to the following code of conduct:

- I will respect my teammates, opponents, coaches, parents, spectators, umpires and myself and will treat all with good sportsmanship and respect.
- I will strive to be the best that I can be and always give my best effort both on and off the field.
- I will remember that I am part of a team and I cannot play a game on my own.
- I will conduct myself in an appropriate manner and try not to bring any disgrace or danger to my teammates, coaches, parents, opponents, spectators, umpires, PVPGSL or myself. I not only represent my team and my league but my district and myself.
- I will demonstrate the highest level of sportsmanship, and understand that winning is desirable but is not the sole reason that I play the game. I will demonstrate good sportsmanship in losing as well as winning.
- I will respect the grounds and facilities that games are played at, to treat all things with respect and report any misuse or abuse.
- I will treat any opponent or teammate with respect. I will encourage the use of only positive cheers for my team; no negative cheers against the opposing team.
- I will not use profanity in any situation.
- I will not steal or mistreat other people's equipment or belongings.
- I am expected to come prepared with my equipment to practices and games. Uniforms must be worn to each game along with designated uniform socks and visors, if applicable.
- I am expected to help keep the playing areas clean, including picking up the area and dugout after each game.
- I will listen to my coaches with respect and obey what they are instructing me to do.
- Although playing time will be equitable, I understand there is no guarantee of playing time or of the position I will play, each game. I agree to play the position(s) assigned to me by the coach.
- I understand and agree to the rules above. I understand that PVPGSL has zero tolerance for inappropriate conduct and that failure to comply with these rules means that I will have disciplinary action taken against me up to and/or including suspension or expulsion from the league.





2022 PARENT CODE OF CONDUCT

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As a parent of Palos Verdes Peninsula Girls Softball League, I agree to the following code of conduct:

- I will treat all players, coaches, umpires, opponents, league officials and spectators with respect. I will never talk down to a player, umpire or another coach. I will not use profanity or inappropriate language, especially directed at a player, umpire or coach.
- I will promote the positive aspects of the game and encourage good sportsmanship at all times, assuring that my daughter adheres to the Code of Conduct and the rules of the game.
- I understand that my daughter is playing the game to learn the game and grow as an individual. Softball is a GAME, and I will always encourage them to have fun.
- I will help to monitor the behavior of spectators and other players and report any problems to the board or the police as needed.
- I will not participate in nor encourage disruptive behavior or disrespecting anyone during all practices, games or events involving PVPGSL.
- I will be supportive of my daughter, her coach, league officials and the rules of the league. I understand that coaches and league officials may correct my daughter if she disobeys the rules. I also understand that if my daughter is observed to continually disobey the rules of the league or the "Player Code of Conduct", disciplinary action may be taken such as being taken out of a game (by coach) or suspended or expelled from the season (by the Board) as they see fit.
- I will not coach my daughter from the stands, understanding that it is the job of the coaches and manager to coach the girls during the game.
- I will not engage in open arguments with coaches or umpires, and I understand that any disagreements should be taken aside and calmly discussed.
- I will not shout or otherwise make my sentiments known about coaches, players or umpires regarding a call or play during a game. If I have questions in regard to a play, I will talk to the manager or coach after the game. I am there to cheer in a positive manner for my daughter and the team.
- Although playing time will be equitable, I understand there is no guarantee of playing time or of the position my daughter will play, each game. I will support my daughter in playing the position(s) assigned to her by the coach.





- I will never threaten or intimidate anyone physically or verbally, especially a child.
- I will not use alcohol, drugs or tobacco at any game or practice.
- I will remember that I am a role model for my child as well as others.
- I understand that I am expected to participate in activities to support the league, such as fundraisers.
- I understand that all registration and fees must be paid before my daughter(s) is allowed to play in a game.
- I will support my daughter to stay and clean up a few minutes after each game.
