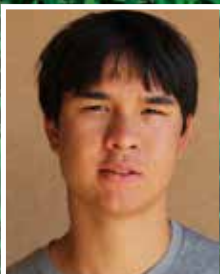

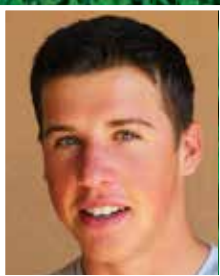

# MEET THE 2017 COACHES: VARSITY



## **JACK SCHRAM** Varsity Head Coach

Jack enters his seventh year as the Head Varsity Football Coach at Miramonte High School. He was a Varsity Assistant Coach at Miramonte from 2006-2010 working primarily with the offensive/defensive lines and was heavily involved in the offensive game plan. Last year Jack doubled as the Head Boys Golf coach

at Miramonte. Prior to coming to Miramonte, Jack was the Head Varsity Football Coach at Encinal High School from 1990-2005. In 1988-89 he was the Varsity Line Coach and Head JV Coach. In addition to football Jack also coached track, wrestling, and golf at Encinal. He has also coached baseball and basketball for middle school athletes. He has been involved with both the boys and girls

Lacrosse program at Miramonte, helping the girls win their first NCS championship in 2015. Jack was a three-sport letterman in football, wrestling, and track at Alameda HS in Lakewood, Colorado. ## **Miramonte 40 Mt. Diablo 0 Friday, Sept. 8th, 2017 CONCORD, CA**

### **Q1**

The Miramonte Matadors Varsity Football played their first away game and 3rd game of the season against the Concord Mount Diablo High School Red Devils. Quarterback #2 Xavier Clark did an excellent job of running the ball with #28 running back Peter Stehr, who ran an impressive 2 touch downs. #4 Henry Marken got one of the extra points, missing one due to a bad snap. The Matadors defensive squad did an outstanding job stopping the Red Devils from gaining yards, with negative yards against Devils offense until the last possession. All of this work and effort kept the Devils from scoring. Great job by all the Matadors, ending the quarter 13-0.


### **Q3**

## **Miramonte 35 St. Mary's 7**

### **Friday, Sept. 1st, 2017 ORINDA, CA**

Q1

The Miramonte Matadors Varsity Football team returned to the home field for its 2nd game of the season against the St. Mary's Panthers from Albany. After the Matadors received the kick off, Quarterback #2 Xavier Clark made a series of very successful hand offs and runs to #28 Peter Stehr and #31 Asim Khan, who carried the ball into the St. Mary's Panthers end zone. Then Xavier Clark ran it in for a touch down at 6:18 and kicker #4 Henry Marken made the extra point. On the Mats kick off, Asim Khan tackled the St. Mary's kick receiver on their 10 yard line. The MATS defense kept the Panthers from scoring and the first quarter ended with the Miramonte Matadors up 7-0.

Q2

At 9:44, Peter Stehr ran in the second touchdown and Henry Marken made the extra point. The Mats kick off Special Teams stopped the Panthers on their 17 yard line with Asim Khan again making the tackle.

The visiting team had several impressive heart-stopping long passes that brought them close to scoring. Running backs Asim Khan and #24 Henry Vacakis had several nice runs, bringing the ball to the Panthers end zone and Xavier Clark ran it to the 15. In a déjà vu, with 2:40 left in the quarter, Xavier Clark handed off to Peter Stehr to score the 3rd touchdown and Henry Marken made the extra point for Miramonte again. With less than 2 minutes left, #11 Will Cassriel had a nice tackle, pushing the Panthers back 4 yards to their 18 yard line. That forced the Panthers to punt, with the Mats receiving on their 32 yard line. A pass-back reverse led to a great 31 yard pass by Will Cassriel to #20 Kellan Stone, scoring the 4th touchdown at 40 seconds left and Henry Marken was successful in making the extra point. The Miramonte Matadors ended the first half 28 - 0.

Q3

The Mats kick-off Special Teams Kellan Stone stopped the Panthers on their 33 yard line. The Mats defense held, forcing the Panthers to kick at the Mats 49 yard line. At 7:46, Xavier Clark pitched to Peter Stehr, who ran it 46 yards before being tackled. 7:27, Xavier Clark passed to Kellan Stone for another touchdown! Henry Marken made his 4th extra point, making the score 35 - 0. #22 Travis Armistead made a tackle, giving the Panthers a 4 yard loss. Henry Vacakis made an interception, running the ball 30 yards into the Panthers 8 yard line. Quarterback #5 Matt Meredith came in and advanced it to the Panthers 3 yard line and was then forced to recover a wild snap back on the Panthers 34. The tough Mats defense of #74 Mark Mezody and #10 Sam Walker held the Panthers and ended the quarter 35 - 0.

Q4

At 6:35, the Panthers picked up a Miramonte fumble, running in the first touchdown for St. Mary's and got the extra point, making the score 35-7. In a series of handoffs by Matt Meredith and runs by #32 Jason Diego Paucar, the Mats made several gains without scoring, ending the game with Miramonte Matadors winning 35 - 7!





## **Miramonte 25 Vanden 7 Friday, Aug. 25th, 2017 ORINDA, CA**

The Miramonte Matadors Varsity Football team started off their 2017 season strong and with an impressive start, with #24 Henry Vacakis receiving the game kickoff and running the ball 30 yards to the Vanden Vikings 45 yard line. After 2 first downs the MATS offense scored their first touchdown of the season with #2 quarterback Xavier Clark handing it off to #28 running back Peter Stehr who scored 6 points. The MATS defense including #74 Mark Mezody and #22 Travis Armistead stopping Vikings #4 Maurice Brown in several plays keeping the Vikings from scoring and ending the first quarter with the MATS up 6-0.

In the second quarter, the MATS did an excellent job holding the Vikings, with #20 Keilan Stone stopping the Vikings running back #4. Unfortunately at 9:57, the Vikings scored (6) and got the extra point (1). After an unfortunate kickoff fumble, the Vikings regained the ball on the Matadors 12 yard line. MATS defense stopped the Vikings from scoring and even pushed them back to the 14. Then MATS #22 Travis Armistead recovered a Viking fumble. 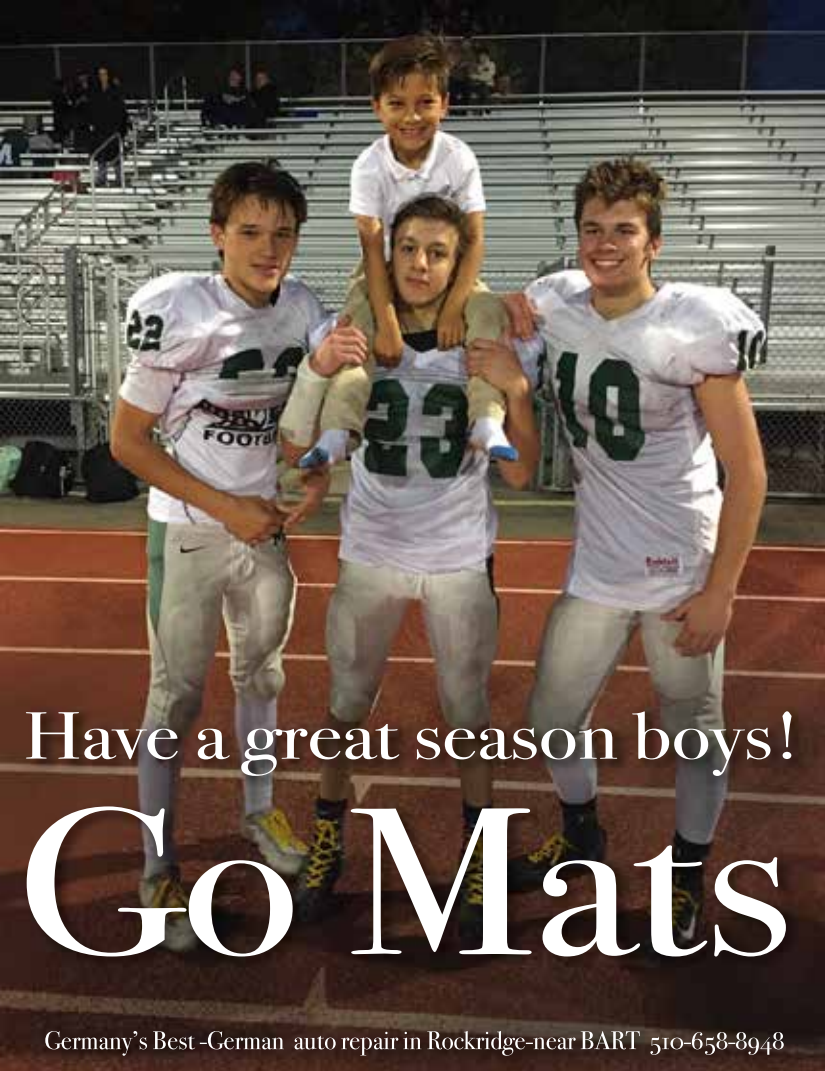
