

DSYSA BASKETBALL

PLAYER DRAFT AND EVALUATION FORMAT AND PROCEDURES

- Team draft order will be determined prior to player selection by a random draw.
 - The draft order will be a continuous “snake” format.
- **TRADES ARE NOT ALLOWED**
- All players will be given a “consensus” evaluation score agreed on by ALL age group coaches immediately following the player evaluations.
- All players not present at player evaluation will be considered “Hat Picks” to be RANDOMLY drawn in order of the draft STARTING WITH THE NEXT PICK ON THE BOARD AND CONTINUEING UNTIL ALL KIDS ARE PLACED ON A TEAM. **These children are NOT available for picking during draft.**
 - Exception- if a DSYSA Basketball Board member is able to provide or confirm an accurate evaluation, the player may be added into the draft process.
- All coaches’ children are “protected” players.
 - A coach must “pick” his child once there are no HIGHER evaluated players available from the “consensus” rating.
 - i.e. A coach whose child receives a consensus evaluation of “3” does not have to use a pick for their child until ALL players rated 4 or 5 have been chosen.
- No pre-determined Assistant Coaches or additional protected players are allowed.
- Any sibling players within the same age group must be drafted onto the same team unless otherwise requested by their parents. The coach must accept both children using his existing draft round choice and must choose the sibling player with their next draft pick AFTER all available players ranked higher than the lower rated sibling are taken. Additionally, the coach may also not choose a player rated equal or lesser than the sibling player prior to picking the lower rated sibling player.
- For combined age groups----
 - There is no separate scoring system for the two age groups; all players are to be judged on the same evaluation scale.
- A coach may pick ANY player at any point in the draft regardless of “consensus” ranking with the exception of the above rules pertaining to their own child or hat picks.
- One member of the DSYSA basketball Board will be present to oversee each draft.
- Any players registered AFTER the draft has been completed will be added to the roster with the next pick at the time the draft was completed and continue in that fashion for any additional late registering players.
- Prior to the draft begins coaches will be given a list of player special requests.
- Coaches will pick practice slots from available practice times in reverse order of the draft PRIOR to drafting teams as to not accidently pick a child with a conflict.
- **THE ONLY EXCEPTIONS TO THE ABOVE RULES ARE THOSE APPROVED BY THE DSYSA BASKETBALL BOARD**
