- **2018-2019 WNYAHL Mite Jamboree League age eligibility: 2010 & 2011 Birth years.** (Smaller Centers may “borrow” players from other centers to fill rosters, but must have approval from the WNYAHL League first, all must be assigned to another WNYAHL Organization)
- All jamboree hosts should follow the rules & guidelines set by the WNYAHL Jamboree League.
- All WNYAHL Jamboree members should be participating in all jamborees, exception is October month when certain organizations programs have not assembled yet. The WNYAHL Jamboree League schedule should take preference over any other outside tournament.
- Only USAH registered players & coaches will be allowed in the player area (on-ice, on-bench). A coach may represent more than 1 team if needed.
- Players are only allowed on 1 roster.
- Preliminary roster/applications should be submitted to the host organizations immediately. (Application forms on WNYAHL site). USAH Hockey generated rosters must be submitted to the host organizations 2 weeks before the scheduled jamboree. DOB certificates must be verified before players are added to rosters. This is done through the clubs registrar and USAH registrar.
- Protective equipment will be required in accordance with USA Hockey Guidelines for the 8U MITE ADM playing level.
- If a Jamboree is shared for that month, it will be up to the hosting organizations to divide which teams play where and notify all teams in a sufficient time span of which center they will be playing at.
- Players are asked to come dressed to rink, except for skates, helmet & gloves. Locker room space is limited. Teams will be assigned a locker room. Players should be ready for their scheduled ice time. There will be only one parent allowed in the locker room with them at a time. Players **MUST** get dressed in the locker rooms they are assigned to; there will be no room in the lobby for them to change there.
- Teams must have their own matching uniforms, in case of the same color being used, pinnies will be provided.
- If possible there can be a goal crease in front of each net (Creases may be spray painted).
- Any players incurring what would be considered reasonable penalties will be sent off the ice for the remainder of their shift. Teams will play shorthanded. If a second penalty occurs, they may substitute one player, not play with 2 men down. Coaches should explain infractions to players and to be used as coaching moment.
- Players should have even playing time, to the best of the coaches’ and time keeper’s ability

- After the rotations of games played, the hosting association will plan an off-ice event for all coaches and players.
- The Jamboree will uphold the USA Hockey Zero Tolerance
- Any type of written correspondence for the WNYAHL Jamboree League should be sent to all WNYAHL Jamboree Contacts and WNYAHL Board Members and section VP David Braunstein.
- The Jamboree is to have fun and promote good sportsmanship among players, coaches, officials, parents and other spectators.
- Infractions of the Zero Tolerance Policy will be dealt with swiftly and fairly to all involved.
