

Zimmerman Youth Baseball Social Media Policy

Players Policy

No player shall post or share statements or photos on Social Media regarding the Zimmerman Youth Baseball Board of Directors, coaches, referees, parents or other players that is, or could be perceived, as negative or derogatory. Should any such post be brought to the attention of the Zimmerman Youth Baseball Board of Directors, the offending player will be warned and the post must be removed immediately. If it is not removed, the Board of Directors reserves the right to remove the associated player from the Zimmerman Youth Baseball program and ban them from any Zimmerman Youth Baseball activity or event. If an offending player has received a warning and repeats the offense a second time, the Board of Directors shall remove the associated player from the Zimmerman Youth Baseball program, and ban them from any Zimmerman Youth Baseball activity or event.

Parents/Guardians Policy

Parents, guardians or associated individual(s) shall not post or share statements or photos on Social Media regarding the Zimmerman Youth Baseball Board of Directors, coaches, referees, parents or players that is, or could be perceived, as negative or derogatory. Should any such post be brought to the attention of the Zimmerman Youth Baseball Board of Directors, the offending party will be warned and the post must be removed immediately. If it is not removed, the Board of Directors reserves the right to remove the associated player from the Zimmerman Youth Baseball program, and ban the offending individual(s) from any Zimmerman Youth Baseball activity or event. If an offending individual has received a warning and repeats the offense a second time, the Board of Directors shall remove the associated player from the Zimmerman Youth Baseball program, and ban the offending individual(s) from any Zimmerman Youth Baseball activity or event.

Coaches Policy

No coach shall post or share statements or photos on Social Media regarding the Zimmerman Youth Baseball Board of Directors, coaches, referees, parents or other players that is, or could be perceived, as negative or derogatory. Should any such post be brought to the attention of the Zimmerman Youth Baseball Board of Directors, the offending coach will be warned and the post must be removed immediately. If it is not removed, the Board of Directors reserves the right to remove the associated coach from the Zimmerman Youth Baseball program and ban them from any Zimmerman Youth Baseball activity or event. If an offending coach has received a warning and repeats the offense a second time, the Board of Directors shall remove the associated coach from the Zimmerman Youth Baseball program, and ban them from any Zimmerman Youth Baseball activity or event.
