1. Minutes

The minutes of the August meeting were approved.

2. Treasurers Report

A copy of the treasurer's report was handed out. It listed the charges due for volleyball and soccer.

Please mail all volleyball, soccer and PLACT fees to Mike Milligan at 3409 N.W. 46th Street, OK 73112. Volleyball is \$325 per team. Soccer is \$275 for Division 1 (grades 1 and 2), \$280 for Division 2 (grades 3 and 4), and \$320 for Divisions 3 (grades 5 and 6) and 4 (grades 7 and 8). The fee for kindergarten is \$215 per team. If these fees are combined into one check, please note how much for each sport and PLACT training. Make checks payable to the CGSAA.

If the person who receives the money for officials, gym use and score keeper is different from last year, please send Mike the name and address of the new contact person at your school.

Volleyball referees will be getting \$30 a game instead of \$25 this year. Mike will send you the difference in a separate check this month. Please remember to pay the refs \$30 per game.

Make sure that your school is keeping a record of what referees are paid each weekend. This record should go to the church office of your school.

The treasurer's report was approved.

3. Unfinished Business –

We discussed different ideas to help build interest in girls' basketball in the 7th and 8th grades.

- a. One idea was to shorten the season so it doesn't conflict with club volleyball. You might want to ask the girls at your school if they would play basketball if the season was only November and December.
- b. Another suggestion was to combine 7th and 8th as one grade-level team.
- c. Another suggestion was to give girls some incentive to play. Perhaps they could get community service hours to support their school team.

4. Soccer

The soccer schedule is set for this year. The Optimist Club did not give Keiffer a final schedule until Sept 6, which made it hard for him to get the schedule checked before he sent it out. He will fix any conflicts, but there will be no changes in the schedule.

If you see conflicts in the two schedules online, follow the "league schedule."

If there is a cancelation due to weather, a notice will be posted on the CGSAA website by 8:00 a.m. that morning.

Please remind families to clean up after their games.

Coaches need to bring a first aid kit and ice for injuries to every game.

Please send Keiffer the names of your soccer coaches and rosters by September 8.

5. Volleyball

Rosters and coach names are due to Beth by Friday, Sept. 8. Please use the roster form from the website to list the girls' names, numbers and coach's name.

Have your coaches take a copy of the rules to each game. Some of the officials are new to our league and are not familiar with our rules.

All forms are available on the CGSAA website. Please email Beth with the scores of the games at your gym each Monday.

The volleyball end of year tournaments will be Oct 28 – 29. The seventh and eighth will be at McGuinness, sixth will be at the Mount and the fourth and fifth tournament will be at All Saints.

6. Basketball

The first estimate of the number of school teams is due at the October meeting. Also due at the October meeting is the CGSAA & Gym Data Form with any gym exception dates. You will be able to access this form on line at cgsaa.org. Please complete it and bring it to the October meeting. Remember that the only game exception days are all-school, required functions.

Remind coaches that the CGSAA combines the teams, coaches and parents should not combine teams. Students needing a team, or teams needing students, will be discussed at a basketball meeting on a Wednesday evening around the third week in October. Gabe will send out an email when the date is set.

The Tulsa tournament will be held on December 9 and 10. There will be no Friday night games, but you might have to play early Saturday morning. The Doubletree Inn has once again given CGSAA teams a special room rate. If you are interested in rooms, call and let them know you are with the CGSAA.

The Mid-Town Classic will be held the second and third weekend in November. There will be more information online.

There will be a coaches meeting this year.

8. PLACT

Thirty-eight coaches received training in August. Megan handed out the certificates and fees for those coaches who were recently trained. PLACT training is \$25 for each person.

Megan is planning to find a week night in November for the next training.

9. New Business

We had a request to start a girls' fast pitch softball program. It was decided that this would not be something we want to add to the sports in the league. We are having trouble finding girls to play volleyball and soccer and adding softball would take girls away from these sports.

Bobby will write a response to the parents who made the request.

A committee was formed to look at the by-laws. The committee includes the executive committee, and a few members from the representatives. They will meet after the next CGSAA meeting on October 4. Joana has sent this committee more information about this meeting.
