



CLEANING RESPONSIBILITY

Dear Hockey Families,

We are excited to share with you some exciting changes for the upcoming hockey season! The McKenzie County Hockey Club has entered into an agreement with the Park District and are now 100% responsible for the two rinks. It is unbelievable how spoiled we are as hockey families to have such beautiful facilities handed to us. That being said, it is now ALL of our responsibilities to keep the facilities looking new. In an effort to keep club fees at a minimum, we will be implementing a cleaning schedule for each team. If we all pitch in, this should require very little time from all of us. Going forward, here is a list of expectations to be completed during your team's cleaning week:

MONDAYS:

- Clean seating area in both arenas with blowers
- Spot mop seating area and concourse area
- Wash chairs (inside and outside of arena)
- Empty all garbage cans (both rinks)

THURSDAYS:

- Clean spectator glass
- Make sure boxes in both areas are clean and the garbage cans have been emptied
- Empty all garbage cans (both rinks)

WHEN YOUR TEAM HAS A HOME GAME:

After your team is done playing, players and parents are expected to walk through the stands and make sure all garbage is picked up. Please empty any full garbage cans. Also, walk through concourse and seating area to make sure anything that was spilled is wiped up or swept.

LOCKER ROOMS:

ABSOLUTELY NO FOOD IS ALLOWED IN THE LOCKER ROOMS!!!

Each team is required to clean their locker room. We have rented a cleaner from the RRC that can be used. Locker rooms are expected to be cleaned on Thursday's so that they are ready for any weekend games. A checklist will be hung in each room with a list of duties. It is each team's responsibility to come up with how they want to rotate the cleaning. If your team shares a locker room you will be on a rotation with the other team. If your lockers rooms are not taken care of and kept clean, your team may lose locker room privileges during practices.

This list is a start, it will take time to work out all of the kinks. There may be items added or deleted as time goes on. We ask that when you are at the rink you all take ownership of it. If you see something that is dirty or needs to be swept up, don't just walk by it. Take care of it like it is your own.
