



2021 ESLL SPRING REGISTRATION

Open to all boys and girls age 5 (by 9/1/2021) up to 12 years old (as of 8/31/2021).

Must be a resident of El Segundo or attend a school in El Segundo.

REGISTER ONLINE BY 8PM PT ON SAT 2/6/2021.

REGISTRATION FEES

\$150 \$120 Spring Cohort Season registration fee – first player

\$100 Spring Cohort Season registration fee – each additional player (*\$20 Discount applies to registration fee for second or more players. All other fees are applicable to each player.*)

Other fees per player: \$10 Safety Fee \$20 Raffle Ticket Buyout

REFUND POLICY: Full refund if requested by Mon 2/15, 50% refund if requested after Mon 2/15 and before season starts on Sat 3/20. No refunds or credits issued after season starts on Sat 3/20, including in the event the City/County requires we end before the cohort season is scheduled to do so (Sun 5/23).

EIGHT-WEEK COHORT SEASON

Due to safety requirements, ESLL will offer eight weeks of cohort-based practices at Brett Field. As much as possible, ESLL will honor requests to play with friends and Managers. Please note: ESLL will **not** have access to school fields so all practices will take place at Brett Field. We may need to **wait-list players** should we not have enough field space. Please register as soon as possible to reserve your spot. Should guidelines change to allow game play, ESLL will pause the season to conduct evaluations, draft teams and collect any fees/deposits. - **ROOKIE / SINGLE A:** One, 60-min practice per week. No more than 8 players, 1 coach: 2 players, 12 people total plus a Safety Monitor.
- **AA:** One, 90-min practice including batting cages. No more than 9 players, 1 coach: 3 players, 12 people total plus a Safety Monitor.
- **AAA/MAJORS:** One, 90-min field practice. One, 60-min batting cage session. No more than 10 players, 1 coach: 3-4 players, 13 people total including a Safety Monitor.

PLAYER ELIGIBILITY

League Age Requirement: All players must be 5 years old on or before 9/1/2021, and cannot be older than 12 years old by 8/31/2021. Absolutely no exceptions. A valid birth certificate is required for all new players in ESLL. Here is a helpful [Little League age calculator](#), as well as the [Little League age chart](#).

Division Requirements: Eligibility for each division requires that all players MUST meet the age range as well as the experience requirements. It is possible for your player to play this year and last year under the same league age.

Division	Eligibility Requirements by Division
Rookie	League Age 5 – 6 (minimum age is 5 by 9/1/2021)
Single A	League Age 6 – 8 AND 1 year of Rookie
Double A	League Age 7 – 9 AND 1 year of Single A
Triple A	League Age 9 – 11 AND 1 year Double A
Majors	League Age 10 – 12 AND 1 year Triple A

FAQ

Q: What adjustments and COVID-19 safety protocols are being made in response to the pandemic?

A: ESLL is implementing a cohort model with strict safety, cleaning and sanitizing protocols to ensure a healthy, safe environment for all those who wish to participate. Please review requirements in the [ESLL 2021 Spring Season Plan](#).

Q: How do I volunteer to help with the League?

A: If you would like to manage, coach or volunteer to help a team or the League in general, review the [ESLL Volunteer Packet](#) and email info@elsegundolittleleague.org with questions. Little League International requires a background check prior to volunteering with any ESLL players.

Q: My child has a friend who does not live in El Segundo. Can this friend play in El Segundo Little League (ESLL)?

A: All players must either be residents of El Segundo, or attend school in El Segundo. For the 2021 season, Little League International has allowed leagues to accept players who otherwise would not be eligible to participate in their league (i.e. the player's home league has concluded or suspended all activity for the 2021 season) as long as they adhere to the approval process outlined on their [website](#).

Q: Am I required to participate in selling tickets for the Opening Day raffle?

A: The raffle is one of ESLL's major fundraising initiatives. Dollars raised help support the League. To ensure participation, we require that you pay \$20 per player at time of registration as a fundraiser buy-out. The money can be recovered when the player sells his/her allotted tickets.

Q: What are registration fees used for?

A: Registration fees cover the costs to operate the league and to sustain ESLL over time. Funds from the treasury supply your child with uniforms, equipment, umpires, fields, and more. The fees also help pay for the League's insurance policy and charter, as well as numerous other League expenses. Because of the COVID-19 pandemic, we are not able to earn revenue from the snack bar and sponsorships as in years past, so registration fees and the fundraising buy-out are needed now more than ever.

Q: How do ESLL registration fees compare to other Leagues in the area?

A: ESLL takes pride in maintaining low fees in order to make baseball accessible for all families. Financial scholarships are available on a case-by-case basis with required documentation. Requests for scholarships are kept confidential. Contact the [League Registrar](#) for scholarship details.

Q: What does the League's insurance cover?

A: The League provides hospitalization insurance and covers your child against accidents that occur while practicing or playing Little League baseball and/or while traveling to and from games, practices or ESLL sanctioned events. The coverage is secondary insurance, which means that you must file claims under your own insurance policy first. Any insurance claim forms should be requested and filed with the League's Safety Officer. For reference, here is the [ESLL Medical Waiver & Release of Liability](#) that is signed and agreed to upon registration for ESLL.
