# Game Summaries

—FRIDAY, DECEMBER 18—

**University School 4, Sylvania Northview 4**—Sylvania Northview (0-0-1/2.0 PTS) came back from a 4-2 third-period deficit to tie University School (0-0-1/3.0 PTS), 4-4, in the opening game of the 2015 Padua Holiday Hockey Tournament. The Wildcats scored twice in the first 2:54 of the third period and that close out the scoring. Senior **Ryan Gorbett** scored the only goal of the first period, giving the Preppers a point under the tournament point system that awards one point per period won. US earned another point in the middle frame, scoring three more times for a 4-2 lead after two periods. Senior forwards **Mark Megerian**, **James Koch** and **Robby Engolia** were the goal-scorers. **Alec Silver** was between the pipes for University School, making 21 saves.

**Saint Ignatius 5, Toledo St. John's 0**—Following a scoreless first period, the Saint Ignatius Wildcats (1-0-0/4.5 PTS) dominated the Titans from Toledo St. John's (0-1-0/0.5 PTS), out-shooting them 35-1 in the second period and scoring four times on their way to a 5-0 win. Junior forward **Connor Koehnke** assisted on four of the five Wildcat goals. Senior **Mark Mastroianni** only had to make six saves to post the shutout for Saint Ignatius. St. John's net-minder **Cole Kaestner** faced 54 shots, turning aside 49 to keep the Titans in the game.

**Olentangy Liberty 1, Padua Franciscan 0**—One goal was enough to win in a goaltending duel between **David Dew** of Olentangy Liberty and **Lynsey Wallace** of the host Padua Franciscan Bruins. Liberty's senior forward **Joey Bergamesca** scored at 8:52 of the second period and Dew (20 saves) made it hold up. Senior forward **Colton Brucker** assisted on the Patriots tally. It was the 300th game in Liberty's varsity hockey history.

**Toledo St. Francis 5, St. Edward 0**—In a re-match of last year's state championship game, won by Toledo St. Francis, the Knights (1-0-0/5.0 PTS) again defeated the Eagles of St. Edward (0-1-0/0.0 PTS), this time by a score of 5-0. Senior forward **Brendan Furry** scored a hat trick and picked up an assist for St. Francis and his classmate, forward **Mike White**, scored the other two goals and also added a helper. Senior goaltender **Kade Phipps** kicked out all 12 shots he faced to post the shutout for the Knights.

**Findlay 3, Lake Catholic 0**—The Findlay Trojans (1-0-0/5.0 PTS) scored one goal in each period to collect the maximum five points in their 3-0 win over the Lake Catholic Cougars (0-1-0/0.0 PTS). Freshman goaltender **Storm Woodward** stopped all 14 shots the Cougars sent his way to record the shutout and sophomore forward **Cameron Armstrong** collected a goal and an assist.

—SATURDAY, DECEMBER 19—

**University School 7, Toledo St. John's 0**—The University School Preppers (1-0-1/7.5 PTS) got up early and picked up a big win, 7-0, over Toledo St. John's (0-2-0/1.0 PTS) that keeps them in the running in the East Division. US surged out to a 4-0 lead in the first period and cruised from there. Seven different skaters scored goals and freshman **Critter Coughlin** made nine saves to register the shutout for the Preppers. Senior forward **Robby Engolia** led the charge with a goal and two assists. Junior goaltender **Zane Intagliata** made 32 saves for the Titans.

**Saint Ignatius 5, Sylvania Northview 0**—In a re-match of the 2014 OHSA state championship game, which was declared a tie after eight overtimes, the Saint Ignatius Wildcats (2-0-0/9.5 PTS) put themselves in the driver's seat for a spot in Sunday's championship game with a 5-0 win over Sylvania Northview (0-1-1/2.0 PTS). Saint Ignatius scored three goals on the power play and another shorthanded. Senior **Dylan McKeon** made 23 saves—11 in the third period—to post the shutout. With at least one goal in each period, Saint Ignatius takes all five possible points, putting them in first place in the East (GLHL) division.

# Game Summaries

**Toledo St. Francis 6, Padua Franciscan 0**—Defending state champion Toledo St. Francis (2-0-0/10.0 PTS) maintained their perfect record—10 out of a possible 10 points through their first two games—with a 6-0 win over tournament host Padua Franciscan. Senior forward **Matt Vild** scored a goal and assisted on three others for the Knights, and senior goaltender **Kade Phipps** made 16 saves for his second shutout in two starts.

**Olentangy Liberty 7, Lake Catholic 1**—Olentangy Liberty (2-0-0/8.0 PTS) won their second game of the tournament, 7-1 over Lake Catholic (0-2-0/1.0 PTS). Liberty junior forward **Tyler Buckerfield** scored two goals 15 seconds apart early in the second period and picked up a helper to spark the offense. Sophomore **David Dew** started in net for Liberty and made six saves before giving way to junior **Logan Senhauser** (10 saves) midway through the second period. Lake managed to take a point out of the loss by keeping the Patriots off the board in the third period and getting a goal from senior **D Kyle Horvath**. Cougars senior goaltender **Jacob Zab** made 23 saves in the game.

**St. Edward 5, Findlay 2**—The Findlay Trojans (1-1-0/6.0 PTS) led, 2-1, after the first period, but the St. Edward Eagles (1-1-0/4.0 PTS) scored four unanswered goals over the final two periods for a 5-2 win. Junior forward **Curtis Szelesta** figured in four of the five St. Edward goals, scoring two and assisting on two others. Senior forward **Jordan Hoy** also scored two goals and added an assist for the Eagles, who had senior goaltender **Warren Hill** (16 saves) in net. Sophomore forward **Brandon Armstrong** scored one Findlay goal and assisted on the other. The win moves the Eagles into third place in the East Division going into their final game this evening against Sylvania Northview at 8:40 p.m.

**Toledo St. Francis 11, Lake Catholic 1**—Senior forward **Kyle Bloom** scored four straight goals to lead the Knights of Toledo St. Francis (3-0-0/15.0 PTS) to an 11-1 win over Lake Catholic (0-3-0/1.0 PTS). The win completed a perfect sweep of three preliminary round games for St. Francis, as they won all nine periods and accumulated 15 points—ensuring them a spot in tomorrow’s 3:30 p.m. championship game. Bloom scored a pure hat trick in a span of 4:18 to close out the first period, then added another early in the second period. He also added an assist in the game. A first-period goal by Lake Catholic junior forward **Logan Walnsch** prevented St. Francis senior goaltender **Kade Phipps** from posting a third straight shutout at the tournament. Freshman **Patrick Kristo** went the distance in net for the Cougars, making 32 saves—18 in the second period.

**Padua Franciscan 1, Toledo St. John’s 0**—Senior forward **Michael Wtulich** scored the only goal of the game and junior **Lynsey Wallace** recorded the shutout as the Padua Franciscan Bruins (1-2-0/5.0 PTS) topped the Toledo St. John’s Titans (0-3-0/2.0 PTS), 1-0. It was the first win of the tournament for the Bruins, who will face Sylvania Northview tomorrow at 9:00 a.m.

**St. Edward 4, Sylvania Northview 1**—Sophomore goaltender **Andrew Stewart** kicked out 16 of 17 shots he faced as the St. Edward Eagles (2-1-0/8.5 PTS) ended the preliminary round on a high note, defeating the Sylvania Northview Wildcats (0-2-1/2.5 PTS), 4-1. With the win, the Eagles finish third in the East (Cleveland-area) Division. Four different skaters scored for St. Edward and senior forward **Jordan Hoy** collected three assists.

**Saint Ignatius 5, Olentangy Liberty 1**—The Saint Ignatius Wildcats (3-0-0/14.5 PTS) secured the top spot in the East Division and a berth in Sunday’s championship game by defeating Olentangy Liberty (2-1-0/8.0 PTS), 5-1. The Wildcats peppered the Patriots net. Hauser made 40 saves. Saint Ignatius spread the scoring around, with five different players finding the net. Senior goaltender **Dylan McKeon** (19 saves) lost his shutout with just 2:38 left.

**University School 8, Findlay 1**—The University School Preppers (2-0-1/12.5 PTS) scored multiple goals in each period, grabbing all five tournament standings points, in an 8-1 win over Findlay (1-2-0/6.0 PTS). It was only enough to get the Preppers a second-place finish in the East Division.

# 2015 PADUA HOLIDAY HOCKEY TOURNAMENT—CHAMPIONSHIP GAME

**Sylvania Northview 3, Padua Franciscan 1**—Senior goaltender **Jarred Wulf** stopped 31 of 32 shots to lead Sylvania Northview past tournament host Padua Franciscan, 3-1, in a penalty-filled game. Padua's senior forward **Michael Wtulich** scored just 1:29 into the second period to tie the game, 1-1, but Northview scored twice before the end of the period to take the lead. The Wildcats out-shot the Bruins, 16-9 in that middle frame, but Wulf made 15 of his 31 saves in the period to turn the tide.

**Olentangy Liberty 3, University School 2**—Sophomore goaltender **David Dew** made 17 of his 43 saves in the third period, preserving a one-goal lead as Olentangy Liberty defeated University School, 3-2. The Preppers led, 2-1, after the first period, but **Jimmy Bursinger** and **Joey Bergamesca** scored second-period goals to give the Patriots the lead. Junior forward **J. D. Clemens** and senior forward **Ryan Gorbett** scored the US goals and senior netminder **Alec Silver** turned back 30 shots.

**Findlay 8, Lake Catholic 2**—Lake Catholic broke the ice just 22 seconds into the game, but the Findlay Trojans scored four first period goals on their way to an 8-2 win over the Cougars. Sophomore forwards **Brandon Armstrong** and **Cameron Armstrong** scored two goals apiece to lead the Trojans.

**St. Edward 5, Toledo St. John's 1**—Junior forward **Curtis Szelesta** scored four goals to lead the St. Edward Eagles to a 5-1 win over Toledo St. John's. **Warren Hill** was in net for the Eagles, stopping eight of nine shots, before giving way to sophomore **Andrew Stewart**, who made 21 saves in the third period as the Titans attempted a comeback.

## —CHAMPIONSHIP GAME—

**Toledo St. Francis 5, Saint Ignatius 1**—Defending state champion Toledo St. Francis won the Padua Holiday Hockey Tournament for the second year in a row, and third time in six years, with a 5-1 win over Saint Ignatius in the title game.

It was the sixth year running that a Toledo-area school won the prestigious tournament which pits top programs from the Cleveland area against contenders from other areas of Ohio.

Senior forward **Kyle Bloom** scored the first three goals of the game for the Knights—his second hat trick of the tournament—and senior goaltender **Kade Phipps** stopped 36 of 37 shots. Phipps, who made 23 saves in the third period, allowed just two goals in four games at the tournament.

The Wildcats out-shot St. Francis, 24-3, in the third period but only managed to get one puck past Phipps. Senior forward **Zack Kisel** scored for Saint Ignatius.
