Game Summaries

—FRIDAY, DECEMBER 19—

University School 4, Findlay 1—**Evan Krueger** scored twice and added an assist as the University School Preppers (1-0-0/4.5 PTS) opened the tournament with a 4-1 win over the Findlay Trojans (0-1-0/ 0.5 PTS). **Alec Silver** allowed just one goal on 22 shots for U. S.

Lake Catholic 2, Toledo St. John's 2—Toledo St. John's (0-0-1/2.5 PTS) took a 2-0 lead early in the third period, but **Colin Clifford** and **Kyle Horvath** scored for Lake Catholic (0-0-1/2.5 PTS) to tie things up. **Will Emch** made 37 saves for the Titans while Charlie Denner turned aside 21 for the Cougars. Each team won a period and comes away with 2.5 points.

Toledo St. Francis 4, Padua Franciscan 0—Terry Burns scored a natural hat trick in the third period for Toledo St. Francis (1-0-0/4.5 PTS), breaking open a close game, and **Quincy Duran** made 21 saves for the Knights as they picked up 4.5 points in their win over host Padua Franciscan (0-1-0/0.5 PTS). **Lynsey Wallace** made 37 saves to keep the Bruins in the game.

Saint Ignatius 7, Sylvania Northview 1—In a re-match of last spring's state championship game, which was declared a tie after seven overtimes, Saint Ignatius (1-0-0/5.0 PTS) won every period and rolled to a 7-1 win over Sylvania Northview (0-1-0/0.0 PTS). **Matty Geither** and **Connor Keohnke** each scored a pair of goals for Saint Ignatius and **Dylan McKeon** made 36 saves on 37 shots. **Jarred Wulf** faced 56 shots in the Sylvania Northview Cage, stopping 49.

St. Edward 6, Olentangy Liberty 0—**Colin Mitchell** and **Jordan Hoy** each scored twice and **Kevin O'Donnell** and **Andrew Stewart** stopped all 11 shots they saw as the St. Edward Eagles (1-0-0/5.0 PTS) had a strong start to the tournament with a 6-0 win over Olentangy Liberty (0-1-0/0.0 PTS). **David Dew** made 42 saves in a losing effort for Liberty.

—SATURDAY, DECEMBER 20— (early games)

University School 3, Toledo St. John's 3—University School (1-0-1/7.0 PTS) came back with three goals in the third period—the third by **Evan Krueger** with 1:40 remaining to give the Preppers their first lead of the game. But the Titans of Toledo St. John's (0-0-2/5.0 PTS) tied it back up 35 seconds later with a goal from **Ian Rapp** to salvage a tie and an extra point in the tournament standings. **Jackson Polish** made 34 saves for U. S. while **Cole Kaestner** stopped 25 pucks for St. John's.

Toledo St. Francis 6, Saint Ignatius 1—**Kyle Bloom**'s hat trick sparked Toledo St. Francis (2-0-0/8.5 PTS) to a 6-1 win over Saint Ignatius (1-1-0/6.0 PTS) Saturday morning. The Knights threw 48 shots on net in the game with **Wes Deacon** making 42 saves for the Wildcats. **Kade Phipps** turned aside 31 of 32 shots for St. Francis as the Knights gave themselves the inside track on the top spot in the West Division.

Sylvania Northview 3, Padua Franciscan 1—**Zach Galecki**'s second goal of the game with 33 seconds left on the clock salted away Sylvania Northview's (1-1-0/4.0 PTS) 3-1 win against tournament host Padua (0-2-0/1.5 PTS). **Preston Due** stopped 21 of 22 shots for the defending state co-champs while **Troy Kozak**'s 37 saves kept the Bruins in the game.

Lake Catholic 6, Olentangy Liberty 2—Liberty (0-2-0/1.0 PTS) scored two goals :22 apart to take a 2-1 lead in the first period, but Lake Catholic (1-0-1/6.5 PTS) stormed back with four goals in the second period on their way to a 6-2 win. **Alex Piazza** notched two goals and two assists for the Cougars and **Charlie Denner** made 27 saves.

Game Summaries

St. Edward 3, Findlay 2—Freshman **Colin Price** scored with 41 seconds left to give St. Edward (2-0-0/9.0 PTS) the win against Findlay (0-2-0/1.5 PTS). The win puts St. Edward in the driver's seat in the East Division going into the final round of games Saturday night. Findlay goaltender **Logan Bern** gave the Trojans a chance to win with a 42-save effort. All three Eagles goals were scored by underclassmen as sophomores **Curtis Szelesta** and **Stephen O'Sullivan** tallied the others. Their classmate **Kevin O'Donnell** made 20 saves.

—SATURDAY, DECEMBER 20—

(late games)

Sylvania Northview 3, Lake Catholic 1—Sylvania Northview (2-1-0/8.0 PTS) came back from a 1-0 second period deficit to defeat Lake Catholic (1-1-1/7.5 PTS) by a score of 3-1. **Kevin Henderson's** 40 saves kept the Cougars in the game as they were out-shot 43-20, but right in it until Northview's **Ian Clement** scored with 4:17 left to give the Wildcats their first two-goal lead of the game. Northview will finish 3rd in the West Division.

Toledo St. John's 6, Padua Franciscan 2—The Titans of Toledo St. John's (1-0-2/9.0 PTS) broke open a one-goal game with three third period goals in a 6-2 win over Padua Franciscan (0-3-0/1.5 PTS). **Ian Rapp** scored a hat trick for St. John's and **Will Emch** made 47 saves. **Derek Dohanos** added a pair of goals for the Titans, who will need some help from St. Edward (against St. Francis) to make Sunday's championship game.

University School 9, Olentangy Liberty 0—The Preppers of University School (2-0-1/12.0 PTS) scored early and often, taking the maximum five points out of their final preliminary round game. **Evan Krueger** scored a hat trick in the first period, and added two assists in the game, while **Alec Silver** stopped all 16 shots sent his way by Liberty (0-3-0/1.0 PTS). The Preppers can finish anywhere from 1st to 3rd in the East Division depending on the results of the St. Edward and Saint Ignatius games.

Toledo St. Francis 5, St. Edward 2—The Knights of Toledo St. Francis (3-0-0/12.0 PTS) won the West Division with a 5-2 win over St. Edward (2-1-0/9.5 PTS). The Eagles can finish no higher than 2nd in the East Division with the loss. With St. Edward trailing 2-1 in the second period, **Collin Mitchell** scored his second goal of the game to tie the score, but St. Francis responded with a goal from **Angelo Procaccini** just 10 seconds later to restore their lead, 3-2. St. Francis will play University School in tomorrow's championship game.

Saint Ignatius 3, Findlay 3—A 45-save effort from **Logan Bern** allowed the Findlay Trojans (0-2-1/4.0 PTS) to come back from a 2-0 deficit and tie Saint Ignatius. **Brian Russell** gave Saint Ignatius the lead back with 3:44 left in the third period, but Findlay responded just 41 seconds later to tie it back up, 3-3.

—SUNDAY, DECEMBER 21—

(consolation/championship games)

Findlay 6, Padua Franciscan 1—The Findlay Trojans scored twice in each period and won their first game of the tournament, 6-1 over tournament host Padua.

Saint Ignatius 8, Olentangy Liberty 1—**Aidan Spellacy** scored four goals to lead the Saint Ignatius Wildcats to a big win over Liberty. The Wildcats close out the tournament with a 2-1-1 record that included a 7-1 win over state co-champion Sylvania Northview. Liberty ends the event 0-4-0.

St. Edward 5, Sylvania Northview 0—**Curtis Szelesta** scored a hat trick and **Kevin O'Donnell** stopped all 14 shots he faced as St. Edward closed out their tournament slate with a win to end at 3-1-0. Northview finished even at 2-2-0.

St. John's 8, Lake Catholic 2—The St. John's Titans exploded for five goals in the third period to break open a close game and defeat Lake Catholic, 8-2. Despite failing to qualify for the championship game, St. John's did not take a loss at the tournament (2-0-2) against a challenging schedule. Lake finished 1-2-1.

Toledo St. Francis 4, University School 2—Toledo St. Francis defeated University School, 4-2, to claim the championship of the 18th annual Padua Holiday Tournament.

Mike White of St. Francis scored the only goal of the first period, as they out-shot U.S., 21-5. Preppers goalie **Alec Silver** kept the game close, making 20 of his 39 saves in the opening frame.

St. Francis built their lead to 3-0 at the end of the second period with goals by **Brendan Furry** and **Kyle Bloom**.

Third period tallies by **Nick Muha** and **J. D. Clemens** got University School to within a goal, but **Terry Burns** gave the Knights an insurance goal that closed out the scoring.

It is the second time the Knights have won the prestigious tournament. They defeated St. Edward in the 2010 title game.
