Retired:

Head Coach 10 years as Head Football Coach in Illinois high schools

Active:

Head Coach 25 years as Football Coach in Illinois high schools with 20 years as Head Football Coach in Illinois high schools and a total of 100 wins

Assistant 25 years as Assistant Football Coach in Illinois high schools

Career Combination of a minimum of 30 years as a Head or assistant Coach

Deceased No set number of years as Football Coach in Illinois high schools

Ray Eliot Award

An award created to bring recognition to a person who we believe is deserving for his contributions to the furtherance of sportsmanship, the quality of the game, and the advancement of athletics in Illinois. We are not required to give this award every year.
