Round Robin Point System

The team with the most points based on Win/Loss/Tie record in each pool will advance to the Championship Game. Points are awarded in each game and accumulated over the three games played by each team during pool play. Points are awarded on the following basis: **TWO POINTS FOR WIN, ONE POINT FOR TIE, ZERO POINTS FOR LOSS.**

If two or more teams in a pool are tied for the Win/Loss/Tie record, the winner will be determined by applying the following criteria in numerical order until a winner is declared.

1. Head to Head records of the tying teams
2. Most wins in pool play
3. Goal differential
4. Fewest goals against
5. Most shutouts
6. Fewest penalty minutes
7. Coin flip

Championship Sunday

If 3rd Place Game and or Championship game is tied at end of regulation, we will play a 5-MIN stop time, sudden-death overtime period. If still tied, a three player shoot-out will attempt to break the tie. If still tied, sudden death shoot-out will occur (all players must shoot once before any player can shoot twice). All other Sunday games that end in tied, stay tied.
