New Business

1. State Meet Bid – March 21-23, 2014
 - a. MISMO is the only gym in the state that has submitted a bid for the State Meet
 - b. SAC proposed accepting MISMO's bid contingent upon improvement of tumbling surface or replacement of the carpet eliminating rips, tears, and folds.

4. Regionals in HELENA – April 11-13, 2014

 - b. Some ideas so far include outreach by means of distribution of flyers/t-shirts, having gyms in the state selling blocks of tickets, promoting attendance for level 10 sessions from our gymnastics community
