3. How big is the typical class size, in general or in my future major?
4. Does the athletic department or my future coach stress the importance of my college education?

5. How much will it cost my family for me to attend school?
6. Is financial aid an option for me?
7. Are there jobs on campus available for student-athletes, and will I have time to work between school and soccer?
8. What is the student enrollment?

9. Will I be competing at the right level for me (NCAA Div. I, II, or III, NAIA, etc.)?
10. Is the soccer program a priority to the athletic department?
11. How well kept are the current athletic facilities?
12. How strong is the current team and what are the current players like?
13. What is my future coach's expectations for me as an incoming freshman?
14. What are the coach's expectations for their athletes in the off-season?

15. How big is the campus itself; can freshman have cars or is there public transportation?
16. How many years can I live on campus? Are there athletic and/or freshman dorms?
17. What are the campus dining halls and meal-plans like?
18. What can I do on or off campus in my free time? How social is the campus itself?
19. Am I the right distance from home; too close or too far?
20. Is this a school and campus I can see myself succeeding at over the next four years?
