Overcoming a ten point halftime deficit, the Titans battled back to take a fourth quarter lead, only to fall short 55-48. Lizzy Shaw led the Titans with 16, followed by Liz LaPierre with 14, Makayla Stadler with 8, Libbie Vanderveen and Kristin Ralston with 4 and Katherine Chu with 2.

The Titans took on league leading New Trier on Friday night and took the CSL South leaders to the limit. The Titans overcame foul trouble and injuries and trailed the Trevians by one with under a minute to go, but fell short 46-43. Stadler led all

scorers with 18 points despite missing several minutes with a sprained ankle. Vanderveen scored 12 despite playing only half the game with foul trouble. LaPierre scored 9 and played terrific defense. Shaw, Ralston, Chu and Challen Flaws battled valiantly on both ends of the court, allowing the Titans to overcome a ten point deficit. The Titans are now 18-8.

Boys Hockey

On Wednesday, the Titan Hockey Club shut-out New Trier Blue by a score of 5-0 behind the brilliant performance of goalie Nic Koster.

The Titan defense, comprised of Stephen Bendewald, Kyle Boland, Max Ibarra, MJ Jenkins, Connor Monagan, and Brian O'Connor, locked down the NT offense which allowed Koster to stop all 15 shots he faced, including a 3rd period penalty shot. The GBS scoring was provided by Patrick Dillon, Theo Papalas, Colin Garrett, Daniel McKay, and Ben Thomas.

On Friday, the Titans made it back-to-back shutouts by blanking Carmel Indiana 6-0 behind a strong performance from goalie Jamie Dziurdzik who turned away 30 shots on goal. Scoring was provided by: Dylan Stevens, Daniel McKay, Theo Papalas, Ben Thomas, Nicolas Botvinnik, and Joe Young.

The Titans played a matinee against Carmel Indiana on Saturday, the first of two that day, and pushed their shutout streak to three by blanking the Greyhounds 4-0. Nic Koster was in net and turned away all 18 shots he faced, including a pair of breakaways. Scoring was provided by Jack Radler, Ben Thomas, Theo Papalas, and MJ Jenkins with a rocket of a shot from the point.

On Saturday night, the Titans completed a three game sweep, in a 24 hour period, against Carmel Indiana. After going more than 10 consecutive periods of hockey without allowing a goal, the Titans took the final match by a score of 4-3. MJ Jenkins, Colin Garrett, Daniel McKay, and Jack Radler each scored, while Jamie Dziurdzik made 27 saves.

The Titans completed the regular season finishing in 5th place in the Scholastic Hockey League and will face GBN in the opening round of the SHL playoffs.
