Who can umpire?

Any male or female aged 14 or older can ump. Special exceptions may be made for the confident younger person who works with a partner. Teens that play softball or baseball are especially encouraged to join us!

When are the games played?

Games are played weeknights (5:30 or 6 pm) and Saturdays (occasional Sundays) from March 17 through the end of May.

Each game lasts approximately 1 ½ hours, and umpires may officiate in back to back games on Saturdays. There are no games during spring break or Memorial Day weekend.

What do Umpires get paid?

The pay starts at \$35 per game for youth umpires; adult and experienced youth make \$45-50 per game. Insurance coverage through ASA is provided free of charge.

Marin Girls Softball League is a non-profit girls recreational fast pitch softball league, affiliated with USA Softball. We serve girls ages 4-15. Umpires are needed for the games in the 3 older divisions -15 and under, 12u and 10u.

What training is provided?

Classroom and On-Field training will be held on Sunday March 4th at the Larkspur Rec Office, 250 Doherty, from 1-4 pm.

**Required for all new and returning umpers.

Our ASA trainer, Sean Beaton, will provide all training and ongoing supervision.

What equipment is provided?

Full chest protector, shin guards, and helmet with face mask are provided at each field. A light blue MGS umpire shirt is provided to each new umpire at the training session. Umpires should provide their own ball/strike counter and can use their own protective equipment if desired.

What is the minimum commitment?

We ask that umpires be available for at least 1 game per week. Assignment is done as far in advance as possible, but we do call umpers last minute to fill in as schedules change.
