Returning All Americans from Fargo automatically get one of the 15 Gold Stipends. Special consideration for returning Fargo National Champion. These athletes must still qualify for the team or be selected to fill OPEN spots.

To qualify for Duals (Schoolboy, Cadet, Junior Men, Women):

- Win Father Devine Tournament. Open slots will be filled by coaches guided by overall point total.

To qualify for Fargo:

- Place in the top 4 in the Region or top 8 in UWW Nationals in age division and style
 - Wrestler may change weights from the weight in which you qualify
- Champion of the State FS/GR tournament qualifies for Fargo, regardless of his # of points.
 - Wrestler may not change weights once you are on the team without permission of the staff.
 - Wrestler may not change weights if that will bump another person already on the team.
- Remaining slots filled by the highest point achievers, regardless or their weight class, assuming we have room in the next person’s weight.
 - If we must skip over someone because we don’t have room in his weight, then he remains at the top in case room opens.
 - Wrestler may not change weights once you are on the team
 - Wrestler may not change weights if that will bump another person already on the team.

For determining stipends for Fargo:

- 15 highest point achievers who qualify receive a “Gold” stipend
- The next 10 highest point achievers who qualify receive “Silver” stipend
- The next 10 highest point achievers who qualify receive a “Bronze” stipend
- All other participants pay full price

Stipends for Dual Teams will be divided among all team members equally.
