

DRESS CODE

Waukesha West Boys Golf Team

Matches: Player must wear the team shirt of the day for that match. This will include one of the team shirts plus the color of the pants designated for that match. Shirts will be tucked in at all times. Pants must include a belt. For matches we normally wear either black or khaki pants. Pants must be of a solid color.

Practice: Player must wear a shirt with a collar or a turtle neck and it must be tucked in at all times. Pants must be of a solid color and must include a belt. Black or khaki pants are always acceptable.

Clothing not acceptable for matches or practice:

Shirts: Shirts without a collar; shirts with printing on them other than a company logo or a company name; sweatshirts; hooded sweatshirts; and any other clothing the coaches deem offensive or questionable.

Pants: Cargo pants; denim; pants not of one color; sweatpants; warm-up pants, any pants without a belt.

Shorts: Shorts of any kind including but not limited to cargo pants or gym shorts or denim.

Hats and visors:

Hats or visors must have the bill facing forward. They may not be worn with the bill in the back or to the side. They may not have offensive wording or logos.

If you come to match or practice without proper attire you will not be allowed to play or practice.

If there are to be any changes to this throughout the season you will be notified by the coaches.
