Helpful Hints

- **NO CLASS REFUNDS, NO MAKE-UP CLASSES**
- Booster lessons and private lessons will help you progress even quicker
- **Protective head wear is not required, but strongly recommended**
- Tie long hair back with a hair elastic
- Wear warm comfortable clothing (not jeans)
- NO SCARVES OR SHORTS
- Please arrive for EVERY class 20-30 minutes *early*. This allows time to get name tag, skates and washroom break for little ones if needed.
- If you arrive to the ice 10 or more minutes after class has started, you will miss your class time for the day, WITHOUT COMPENSATION (ie.: no makeup's, no passes, no refunds). We understand there are times that you may be delayed, but other class members that made the effort to arrive to class on time should not be held up because of another students tardiness. Remember, classes are only 30 minutes long.
- The best way to improve your skill and get the most value for your money is to stay after class and skate on the public session. Lynnwood Ice Center offers public sessions 7 days a week, so come skating on a non-class day to really solidify the skills you learned in class. Bringing a friend to skate with your student will also help them learn through helping.
- If you have questions, comments or concerns TALK TO US! We are always happy to talk to students and parents about skating, their class and/or experience in our program.
- Remember long socks, mittens or gloves.
