

FLRHA "Central Outlaws" and Information guide for 2018-2019 season

All Practices and home games hosted at "CRC- The Rink"

Objective – To balance home and away contests while scheduling competitive games. This will minimize travel costs as well as have a 3:1 ratio of practices to games.

Travel Season and Schedule:

Practice and Season begins September 11, 2018 (2 practices per week)

Skills and Drills begins September 21, 2018 (1 session per week)

Tournament Squirt & Pee Wee division October 19, 20, 21

Games begin October 7th and conclude by March 3rd (1 home ice slot every weekend)

16u/18u teams will begin season no later than Sept. 1 to satisfy USA hockey game count requirements

- 10 team practices, required before the first game
- 8 individual practices, required before first game
- Game limit guidelines per level per season:
 - Bantam 30 + 2 Away Tournaments
 - Pee Wee 30 + 2 Away Tournaments
 - Squirts 30 + 2 Away Tournaments
 - 16 u 20 + 4 Away Tournaments
 - 18 u 20 + 4 Away Tournaments

Fall sport seasons take the precedence over the beginning of hockey season. **Parents** should manage participation accordingly and work with coaches.

Guidelines for athletes:

- One practice "option" per day allowed, (any sport) "Fall" In policy – "Spring Out" policy
- Recommended one game per day (tournaments excluded)
- One day off per week
- Three game hockey weekends are not recommended unless roster size is a minimum of 16 player quantity. Tournaments are exceptions

Tournaments:

- Squirt and Pee Wee team hosts and participate in the October home "Outlaw Border Classic" at The Rink.
- SQ , PW, BANTAMS teams also may schedule a maximum of **two additional overnight tournaments**. Away tournaments are funded by parents however FLRHA has included a \$500 voucher per event for sq, pw and bantams to help with cost.
- The scheduling tournament limitation excludes advancement in tournaments such as Sectionals, Silver Stick or NYS State Tournament. Parents/Guardians and coaches will be responsible to fund additional advancement tournament play.
- 16u and 18u **four overnight** tournaments are not included within registration fees nor include any voucher, and are the financial burden of each team.

School attendance is important – Therefore, scheduling efforts should be made to eliminate the need for athletes to be absent from school.

Mite and Learn To Play programs:

*Practice begins October 5th ending March 3rd.

*Mites will be broken into two division first year players and second year players

*First year - Practice training and in house games against one another

*Second year – Practice training and games against other associations some travel

*Move Up Policy- If a first year player shows exceptional skills he will be moved to advanced second year age division.

*Mite program will host one home tournament either President Holiday or MLK Holiday

*All Mite parents must register players thru www.fingerlakeshockey.com prior to entering the ice surface. NO Exceptions. All aspects of registration including payment must be completed by this time.

*All Learn to Play (I.P.) begins October 6th held Saturday and Sunday afternoon, Ends March 4 all players must register www.fingerlakeshockey.com before entering the ice

Travel Team Tryouts

April 13, 14, 15 (\$150.00 tryout fee made payable by check: Finger Lakes Regional Hockey Assoc.)

If selected for the team \$100 will be removed from season league fees. Those not selected there will be no refund granted.

Players attending tryouts that were not registered as Central Outlaws last year must show proof of player release form. It must be signed by the President of your previous association and submitted in hard copy.

Squirt Travel birth year 2008, 2009 – \$1380 due 9/1/2018 applied tryout credit \$100

Pee Wee birth year 2006, 2007 - \$1380 due 9/1/2018 applied tryout credit \$100

Bantam birth year 2004, 2005 - \$1380 due 9/1/2018 applied tryout credit \$100

16u / 18u birth year 2000,2001,2002,2003 - \$1380 due 9/1/2018 applied tryout credit \$100

Selection Process and announcement of Travel teams:

Wednesday April 18 team rosters will be posted with selected players for the 2018-2019 season at Community Recreational Center, selected parents and players are asked to attend between the hours of 5:30 and 6:30pm to complete the Player/Association Commitment form and uniform distribution.

Players not selected for the team will be notified by the head coach prior to April 18th of this decision and will explain alternative training options for the season.

Without this form signed you cannot be considered for the team of the 2018-2019 season. This policy has been set forth by NYSAHA Central Section President- Gary Lebrun- USA Hockey District Director

Recreation Teams:

Tryouts are June 9th; FLRHA will be offering both a Squirt and Pee Wee Recreational Independent travel team this season. A less intense commitment to the travel team experience, these teams will receive one team practice, one skills session and 20 home game sessions.

Squirt birth year 2008, 2009 - \$980.00 is due 9/1 applied tryout credit \$100

Pee wee birth year 2006, 2007 - \$980 is due 9/1 applied tryout credit \$100

Tryout Fees are \$150 non- refundable made payable to Finger Lakes Regional Hockey Assoc. if selected \$100 will be credited towards season fees

Season Begins: October 3rd thru March 10th.

20 game season – 1 home tournament hosted March 8, 9, 10

These teams and players are required to attend 5 team practices before scheduling or playing in their first game
