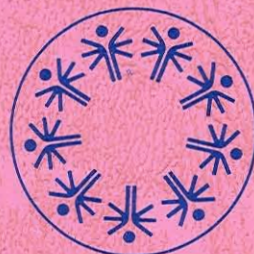

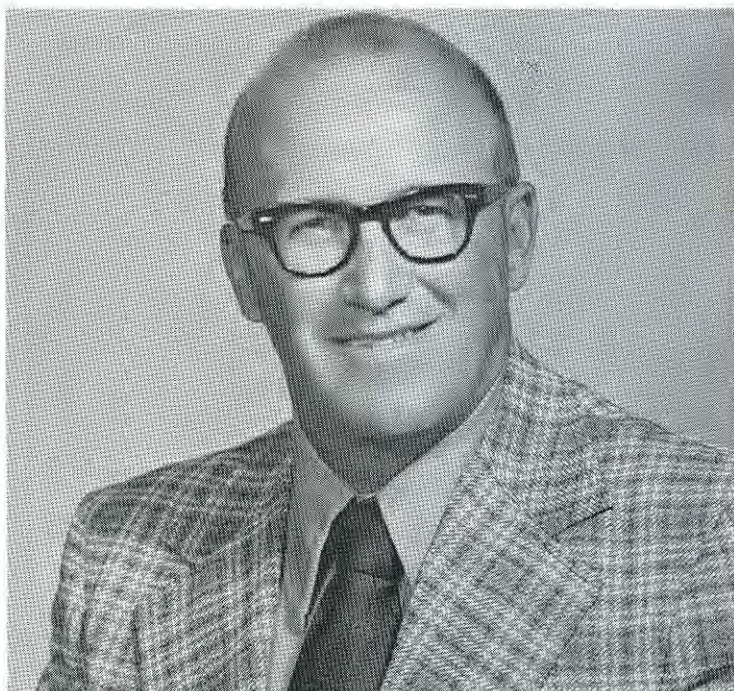

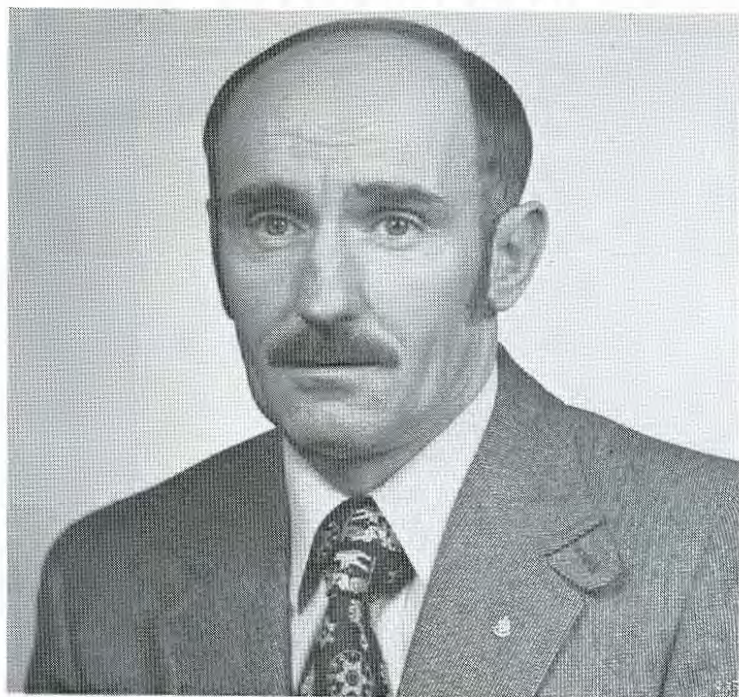
1981 BOYS CROSS COUNTRY COACH OF THE YEAR

JOE LOCKWOOD, SIOUX FALLS WASHINGTON

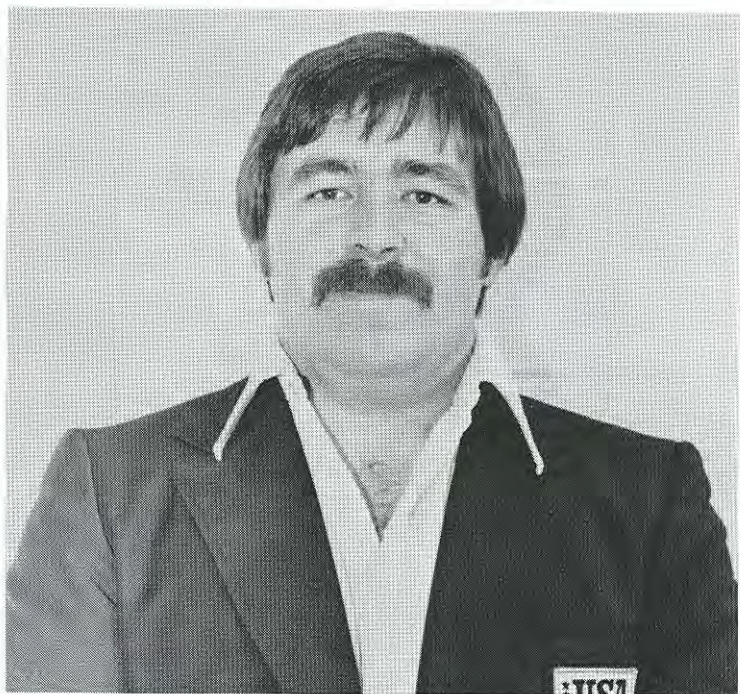


Lockwood coached his team to two straight State A titles and was also named the Coach of the Year in 1980.

Forseth began teaching and coaching gymnastics at Lincoln in 1969, was at Washington in 1973, and returned to Lincoln in 1979. Her career record is 76-7, and 14 of her girls have won individual state championships.

"I love the sport because it demands so much of a person. I've been fortunate to have had good kids . . . they've been loyal and worked hard."



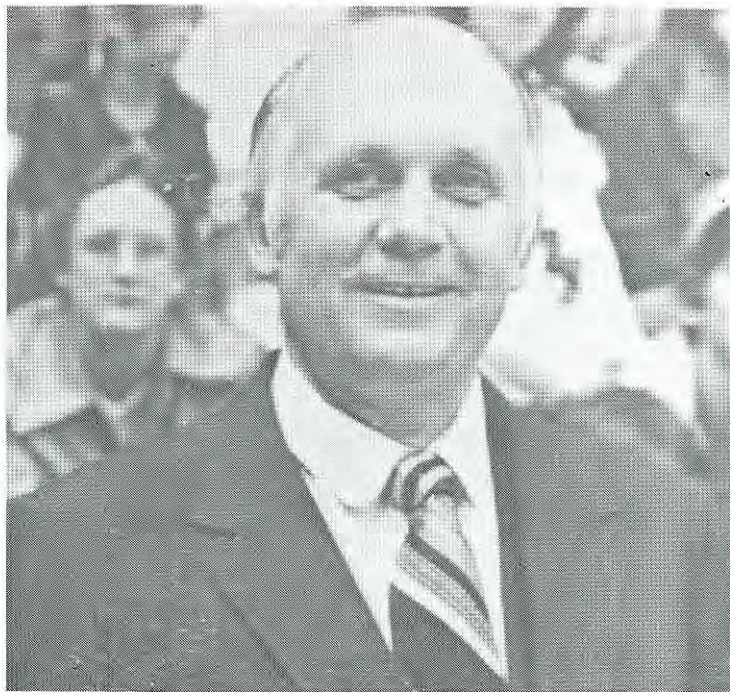
1982 BOYS BASKETBALL COACH OF THE YEAR

LARRY LUNDEEN, PIERRE

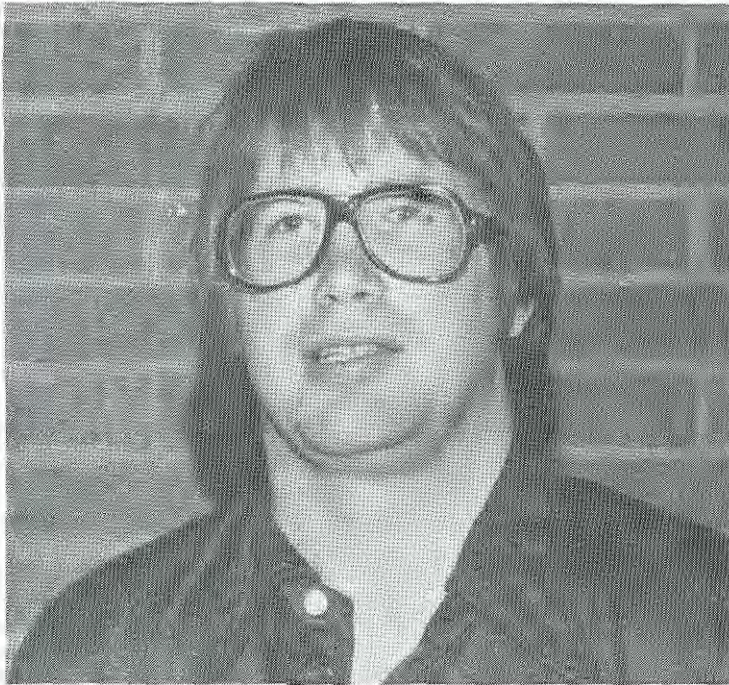


Lundeen has been head coach of the girls' track team for three years, following thirteen years as the assistant boys' coach. He has also been their cross country coach fifteen years.

BRUCE OLSON, WEBSTER

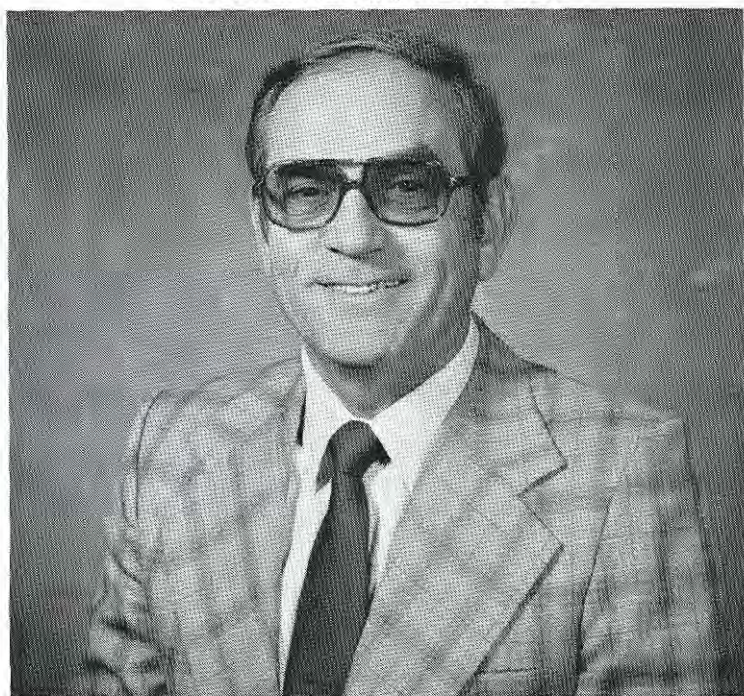


During Olson's three years as golf coach in Webster the school has added a girls' golf program and built on the boys' winning tradition in golf.

WARREN E. WILLIAMSON, BROOKINGS



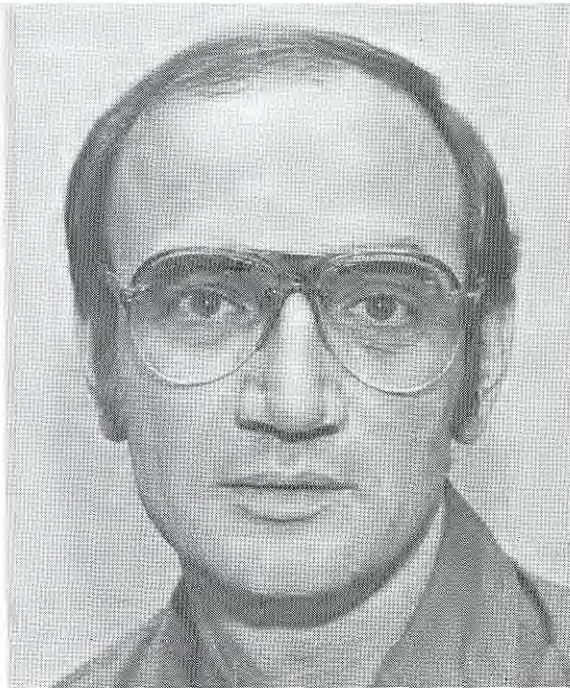
Given for outstanding contributions to high school athletics and dedication to the highest and best in high school athletics.

Dubbed the "Father of Wrestling in South Dakota," he received the South Dakota College Coach of the Year award in 1966 and the Ralph Ginn Coaching Award in 1973.
