SCHEDULE FRIDAY, APRIL 20TH

Weigh-ins 7 p.m. – 8 p.m. for those who did not do satellite weigh-ins – must wear singlet

SCHEDULE SATURDAY, APRIL 21TH

7:00 a.m. – 8:00 a.m. Weigh-ins for those who did not do satellite weigh-ins – must wear singlet

9:00 a.m. Officials and coaches meeting

9:00 a.m. Pre-Bantam through Intermediate: check brackets and report changes to head table**

9:30 a.m. Pairings meeting

10:00 a.m. FREESTYLE /GIRLS ONLY wrestling begins: Pre-Bantam through Intermediate

12:00p.m. Novice through Open: check brackets and report changes to head table**

1:00 p.m. FREESTYLE/GIRLS ONLY wrestling begins: Novice through Open

****No bracket changes made after 9:40 a.m. or 12:40 p.m. All wrestlers should arrive at least one hour before start time to check brackets.**

REGISTRATION: Pre-register by midnight Wednesday, April 18th through www.trackwrestling.com and weights entered by midnight Thursday, April 19th if doing satellite weigh-ins. Email team weigh-in sheets to ausawpairings@gmail.com by the morning of Friday, April 20th. Original weigh-in sheets must be brought to the tournament and turned in to the head table. Individual wrestlers are welcome but must have a valid USA wrestling card purchased from www.usawmembership.com prior to the tournament.

FEE: \$20 for each wrestler. Clubs should make one check, payable to Alaska Battle Cats, for all wrestlers registered for the tournament.

GIRLS ONLY BRACKET: Girls only brackets will run simultaneously throughout the day of the freestyle tournament. It is your responsibility to watch both brackets if you choose to enter both tournaments.

COACHES AND PARENTS: Parents and spectators will not be allowed on the mats, the exception being made for Pre-Bantam and Bantam wrestlers when one parent will be allowed on the edge of the mat. Coaches must have the Copper Certification, proof of concussion training and Safe Sports training certificates to be in the corner. Videographers must purchase a wristband (\$10); only one videographer per wrestler allowed on the mat. Security will be enforced.

CONCESSIONS: Concession stand will be available during the tournament.

HOSPITALITY ROOM: Wristbands will be provided during the coaches meeting to those who provide current coach's card, identification and current concussion and Safe Sports training certificates.

AWARDS: Medals will be given to the top three wrestlers in each weight division. Madison bracketing will be used.

EQUIPMENT: Headgear is required for School-boy/Girl and younger divisions and all girls up to Cadet. Mouth guards are required for wrestlers with braces.

QUESTIONABLE SKIN CONDITIONS: Require a completed "Physician's Release" for which can be found under "forms" at www.ausaw.org. Any conditions considered questionable by the Head Mat Official without a physician's release will be cause for forfeit from the tournament.
