Undefeated Girls Soccer Wins Deep Dish Soccer Classic

The GBS Girls Varsity Soccer team (8-0-3) continued their winning ways by earning the 2018 New Trier/Loyola Academy - Lou Malnati's Deep Dish Soccer Classic championship title.

The Titans are still undefeated, ranked #18 with ChicagolandSoccer.org, and set a new school record for the longest undefeated streak to begin a season.

Last week, the Titans defeated the Lake Forest Scouts, 3-1, last Saturday to begin the tournament. Then followed up a fantastic week on their way to the championship earning sweatshirts and a free pizza party on behalf of Lou Malnati's!

On Monday, GBS tied #4 Loyola Academy, 1-1, after conceding an early 8th minute goal, the Titans earned a corner kick in the 16th minute and junior midfielder Grace Evans bent in a corner kick to an awaiting junior forward Makayla Stadler for the lone tally for the home squad. (See video of the game winning goal on our Facebook page). The two rivals continued to trade blows as the match continued but remained a stalemate until the very end giving GBS a well-earned tie. The defensive line of Gracie O'Brien, Katie Sullivan, Christie Chrones, Challen Flaws, Jessica Peters, and Caroline Hensing held strong against the offensive prowess of the Ramblers.

The team earned a birth to the semifinals after advancing on a goal differential tie-breaker and took on Friday night #7 Naperville North at New Trier's Northfield campus. The physical back-and-forth match could not be decided in regulation. With the "golden goal" rule, the teams played two overtime periods, and sophomore forward Katie Weiss served in a corner kick ball that somehow found the head of Makayla Stadler from 15 yards out, in the 95th minute and gave the Titans a walk-off victory over the Huskies, 1-0. The incredible midfield play from Grace Evans, Lauren Meier, Katie Gates, Dana Steffen, Julia DiSano, Caroline O'Shaughnessy, and Alexandria Shaw stymied the Naperville North attack for the entire match. Junior goalkeeper Libbie Vanderveen got a clean sheet with five saves and made a huge game-saving stop at the end to help put the Titans in the title match.

Another brutally cold, windy, and wintry day brought fellow CSL South rival Evanston for a rematch from the March 23rd contest for the championship game in Northfield. The Titans held strong going into the wind in the first half and earned a scoreless tie at halftime. Early in the second half (42nd minute), sophomore midfielder/forward Ellie Flowers passed to Katie Weiss who took a shot from 25 yards out and it trickled in between the legs and "nutmegged" the Wildkit goalkeeper for the eventual game winner, 1-0. Playing without four girls in this match, the unbelievable efforts from Izzy Archer, Lauren Mah, Lizzie Garvey, Annie McMahan kept Evanston at bay. Junior goalkeeper Libbie Vanderveen made four saves including a key breakaway save with 45 seconds remaining in the match to earn her second consecutive shutout for the Titans and the 2018 Lou Malnati's Deep Dish Soccer Classic championship title! The Titans take on Tuesday, April 17, the #2 New Trier Trevians (5-0-2) in Glenview and John R. Davis Stadium at 7:00 p.m. for a chance to at least share the CSL South Division title and a possible shot to earn the #1 seed for the IHSA Class 3A state series for the Glenbrook South Sectional.

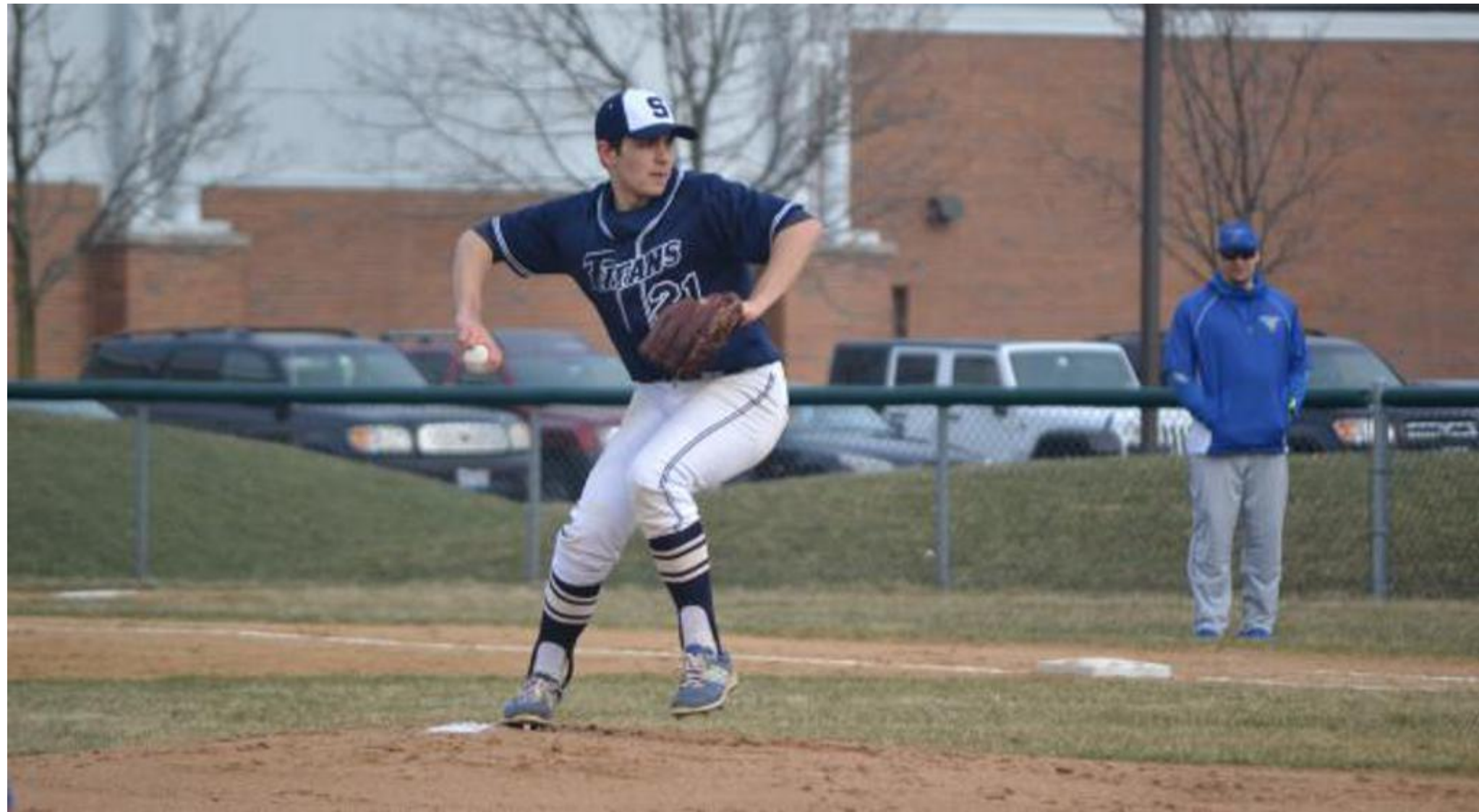

The Glenbrook South varsity baseball team won Thursday's home conference game against Vernon Hills (IL) by a score of 9-1.

John Miskella's pitching, along with one of the host Titans' (5-7, 1-1) stronger offensive efforts led to a 9-1 win.

"The same thing happened to me on our spring trip. The first pitch was a moonshot," Miskella said. "But I was able to get out of that situation and I stayed confident. I was making sure I was throwing strikes and letting my defense make plays behind me."

Miskella had quality pitches that carried him throughout his six innings.

"I was very happy with my fastball most of the way," Miskella told the Glenview Lantern. "As the game went on, I lost a little on it so I went to my slider and was able to rely on that in the later innings."

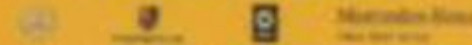
