Girls Soccer

GBS Girls Varsity Soccer continues to play at a very high level through a grueling scheduling.

The girls came into games this as the #3 ranked Chicagoland area team in the latest rankings according to ChicagolandSoccer.org.

The Titans suffered their first loss to #4 New Trier on Tuesday evening by a score of 0-3. Junior goalkeeper Libbie Vanderveen made three highlight reel saves to keep the Titans in the match before succumbing at the very end.

On Friday, the team traveled to take on the Zee-Bees of Zion-Benton and were victorious 7-0. Senior midfielder Annie McMahon tallied twice in the first half with goals in the 17th minute and 21st minute (assist from Junior midfielder Grace Evans). Junior forward Makayla Stadler tallied her

10th goal of the season from Sophomore forward Katie Weiss in the 43rd. Grace Evans got on the scoring barrage unassisted in the 54th minute. Junior forward Izzy Archer scored her first career varsity goal in the 61st minute on a helper from Senior midfielder Alexandria Shaw. Senior midfielder Lauren Meier tallied in the 71st and to finish the victory was Katie Weiss burying her shot in the 80th minute from a Makayla Stadler pass. Sophomore goalkeeper Jessica Ehlinger earned first ever varsity win and shutout in net making one save.

Saturday, the team hosted the #1 ranked Normal Community Iron in the non-Chicagoland area to John R. Davis Stadium. An extremely physical game that had 17 total fouls between the opposing sides, the action from endline-to-endline provided great dynamic play for 80 minutes. Libbie Vanderveen got another shutout as she made one save between the pipes and the Titans outshot NCHS by a count of 9-1 with nine corner kicks taken. Defenders Katie Sullivan, Christie Chrones, Caroline Hensing, Jessica Peters, and Grace O'Brien turned away the Lady Iron attack all-afternoon long. Even with the great effort defensively, it just fell short offensively on the scoreboard with the Titans settling for a 0-0 tie.

The Titans are now 9-1-4 for the season and host CSL South Division foe, the Niles West Wolves (7-4-1) on Tuesday night at 7:00 PM.

The 9th Annual GBN/GBS Glenbrook Cup begins Thursday night versus the Rockford Lutheran Crusaders (5-2-0) in the tournament quarterfinals in the stadium. Deerfield (11-2-1) and Glenbrook North (4-0-3) are very strong contenders to get in the way of the Titans in their quest to reclaim the Glenbrook Cup title.

GBS will be a host site Thursday and Friday evening with all games on Saturday at Techny Prairie Park in Northbrook.

Varsity Badminton Continues to Show Their Strength

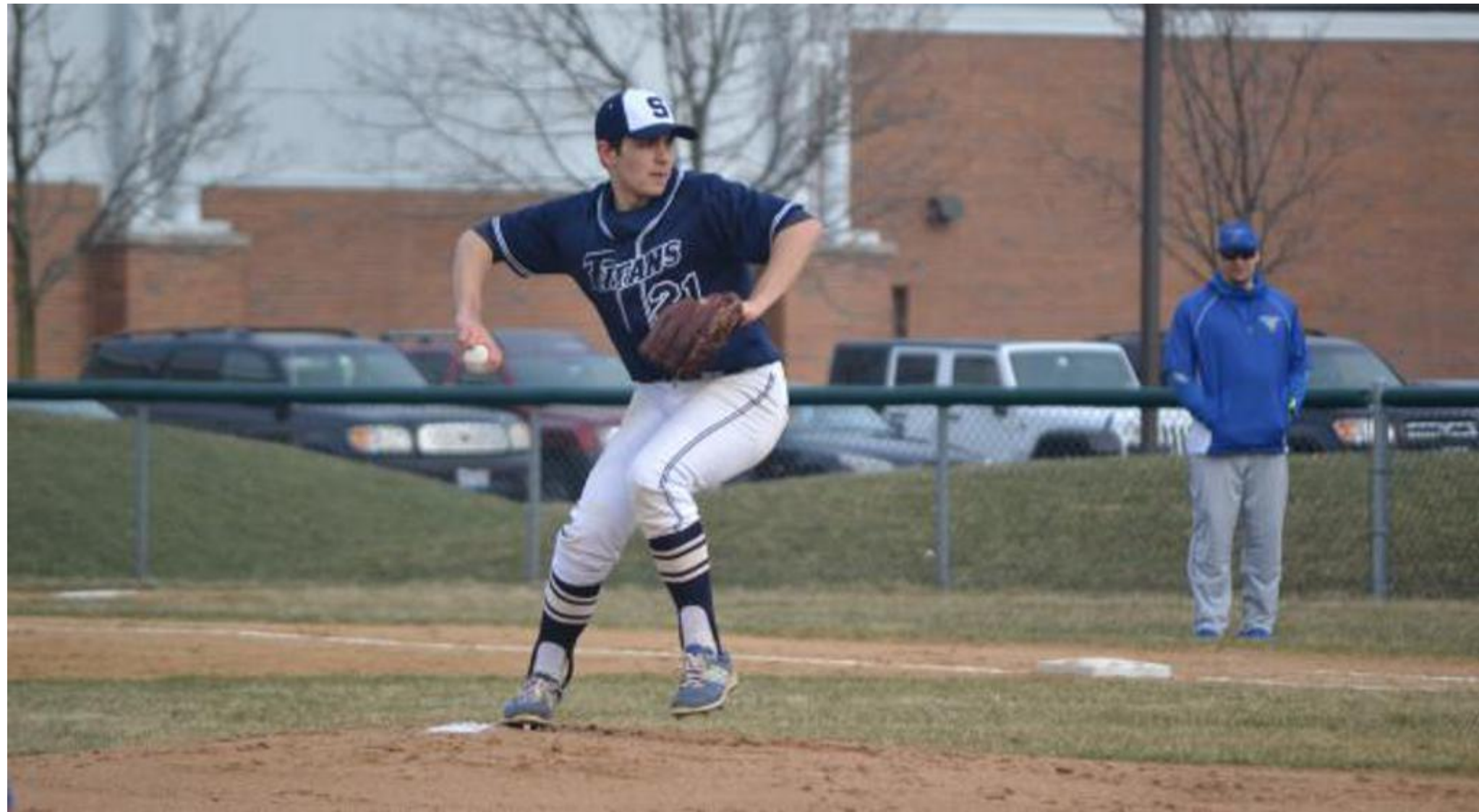
Tuesday, GBS met the perennial tough opponent New Trier. The Titans had a convincing win of 12-6!
