



Team Colorado 19U Tier I Program

Mission

Team Colorado 19U offers the state's top female hockey players the elite coaching and training to prepare them for competing at the collegiate level. The team participates in highly competitive games across the country and the training program mirrors an NCAA training model. The aim is to equip players with athletic and life skills for the next phase of their hockey careers.

Competition Schedule

The 19U Tier I team will compete in ten Tier I events throughout the 2018-2019 season. Each of the following events has been selected due to their exposure to high caliber competition and NCAA college coaches.

19U Season Training Schedule

Players making a commitment to hockey at this level are making hockey a top priority in their life.

The following weekday schedule is designed to provide 19U players with the opportunity to train in an elite athlete setting while allowing them to succeed academically.

In keeping with school schedules, there will be a one week break at Thanksgiving, and two week winter break at Christmas (Exact dates will be posted on 19U team calendar). Due to the scheduling of Nationals, there will be **NO** Spring Break.

Selection Process

The 19U Tier I team will be comprised of a minimum of fifteen skaters and two goaltenders. We are looking for 17-20 student-athletes who have a commitment to train and compete at the Tier I level. Players must also be committed to excelling in academics and hold themselves to a high standard of good character and integrity.

Post Tryout Process

Players participating in the tryouts for Team Colorado will be notified by email and/or phone within 48 hours of the tryouts as to their status of making the team.

Player Age Eligibility

Players must be a 1999 - 2002 birth year to be eligible for the 19U Tier I program. "Play Ups" will be kept to a minimum and will only be granted on a case-by-case basis.

Residence Policy

Making a commitment to a high performance 19U Tier I program often means players must move away from home. Training as a team is critical to our collective success and to enable players to reach the NCAA.

If a player lives outside the Denver Metro area, they are encouraged to take advantage of the billet/housing program. For more information on the billet program, please contact Coach Chad MacLeod.

Estimated billet costs - \$350/month (\$3500 total)

College Advising

Players making a commitment to train in a 19U Tier I environment are likely pursuing a pathway to the NCAA or ACHA as a student-athlete. Figuring out which NCAA or ACHA program is right for you can be daunting and at times confusing. Players who make a commitment to play on Team Colorado's 19U Tier I team will receive college advising at no additional cost.

19U Season Fees (\$4000 per player)

This fee includes all pre selected tournament registration fees. It also includes all practice ice, practice jerseys, coach stipends, and association admin/overhead costs.

Team/Travel Fees

Travel fees are paid monthly and covers Coach travel and expenses: flights, hotel rooms and meals. Also included are team hotel rooms, and team transportation. Families will be expected to pay the Team Treasurer by stated deadlines before each trip.

The 19U Tier I team will travel as a team and will be the responsibility of team officials. Players need to travel on team flights and stay in team hotel rooms. Parents are invited and encouraged to travel to game weekends, but need to stay in their own hotel room at the team hotel or a hotel of their own choosing.

Flights

Players will travel on designated team flights as chosen by the Head Coach and are paid for by each family separate from season fees and travel fees.

Equipment Package (Estimated price for new players \$400 - \$600)

All players on the Team Colorado 19U Tier I team will be required to purchase an equipment/apparel package. The package includes game jerseys (home and away), game socks (home and away), pant shells, one travel quarter zip and track suit. Equipment bag, navy gloves, and navy helmets are required items, but are not included in the equipment package. Returning players will need to purchase the track suit.
