## 1. PVBC – About Us

- Established in 2013 - 501(c)(3) non-profit organization run by volunteers who love the sport of volleyball
- Mission: Grow the sport of volleyball within the Pewaukee School District and to instill the love of the game in every player.
- Goals:
  - Introduce/enhance the core fundamental skills of VB
  - Create a fun, energetic & competitive atmosphere for kids to enjoy the game of VB
  - Emphasize teamwork, skill development, leadership and personal growth
  - Promote and develop volleyball players for the PHS VB program

- Nov-Apr/Jun: Club Volleyball (5<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup>)
- Jan-Mar: Asa Middle School Girls Volleyball (7<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup>)
- Jun-Aug: Summer Camps (all ages):

## 4. BRYFVL Fall Program Overview

- Participate in BRYFVL - Badger Region Youth Fall Volleyball League (formerly WYVL)
- BRYFVL took over the 10-year running WYVL this year since Center Court was sold and no longer running it. Badger Region Volleyball Association is now running this league.
- Open to all (boys & girls) 5<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> (2019/2020 grade) students that either live within the Pewaukee School District and/or those that attend Pewaukee Schools
- No cut program – everyone that wants to play will be on a team

## 5. Practices

- Begin week of 8/19
- Practice 2 times/week for 1.5-2.0 hours
- All practices at one of the Pewaukee School gyms
- Always arrive 15 mins prior to practice start time for putting on gear and setting up nets.
- Communicate all absences/conflicts with your child's coach as early as possible.
- Master practice schedule to be posted on website.

## 6. Matches

- Starts weekend of 9/7 through weekend of 10/26
- Play 2-3 matches on Saturday and/or Sunday in a play, sit, play type format
- Each match is ~45-60 minutes. Play 3 sets (games) per match with 1<sup>st</sup> 2 games to 25 and 3<sup>rd</sup> game to 15
- Matches will be at Center Court or Sting facility in Menomonee Falls.
- League ending tournament weekend of 10/26

## 7. Playing Time Guidelines

- 5<sup>th</sup> Grade – Everyone plays equally
- 6<sup>th</sup> Grade A – Everyone plays equally for ~75% of the match – Coach's discretion for other ~25%
- 6<sup>th</sup> Grade B – Everyone plays equally
- 7<sup>th</sup> Grade A – Everyone plays equally for ~50% of the match – Coach's discretion for other ~50%
- 7<sup>th</sup> Grade B – Everyone plays equally for ~75% of the match – Coach's discretion for other ~25%
- 8<sup>th</sup> Grade A – Coach's discretion but everyone should play every match
- 8<sup>th</sup> Grade B - Everyone plays equally for ~25% of the match – Coach's discretion for other ~75%
- 5/6 Boys will follow 6A above
- 7/8 Boys will follow 8B above
- League Tournament (5<sup>th</sup> & 6<sup>th</sup>) – Everyone plays equally for ~50% of the match – Coach's discretion for other ~50%
- League Tournament (7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup>) – Coach's discretion
- Adjustment factors include practice participation, attitude, work ethic, etc.

## 8. Teams

- Try to keep teams to minimum of 9 players but less than 12. Not always possible.
- If not enough players at a given grade, they will be combined with grade above them.
- Boys & girls will not play with or against each other.
- If there are enough players to have 2 or more teams for a given grade, an assessment will be done.
- For girls 6<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup>, if there are enough for 2 teams, there will be an A team & B team

## 9. Coaches

- Teams are Parent coached for most part.
- Very difficult to find non-parent paid coaches.
- All coaches must be USA Volleyball IMPACT certified.  
Only needs to be done once in coaching career.
- Coaching assistance will be provided to all coaches.
- Volunteer head coaches do not have to pay the \$175 fee for their child
- Assistant coaches pay reduced fee of \$75 for their child

## 10. Uniform/Equipment

- Game jersey top (included in \$175 fee)
- Knee pads required (player's expense)
- Long hair should be in ponytail
- Preferred shoes in order are: volleyball, cross-trainer and running/basketball (player's expense)
- No jewelry to be worn during practice & games (including earrings)
- For practices and tournaments, always bring water bottle.

## 11. Fees & Forms

- \$175 fee includes jersey top, equipment costs, league fee and coaching expenses
- \$15 Badger Region Membership for those that did not play club VB in 2018/2019 (instructions will be added to website for this)
- Fees are non-refundable once paid.
- Coaches have some expenses that will all be reimbursed
- All players need to have 3 forms completed – 1) registration form (online) 2) medical form (hard copy); & 3) concussion form (hard copy)
- All forms and fees must be received prior to teams being developed

## 12. Parents

- Need 2 volunteers/match to do line judging & the score table – coordinated by coaches
- Appreciate your child's efforts; children should know that win or lose you love them.
- Be honest to yourself about your child's athletic/skill capacity, competitive attitude & sportsmanship.
- Do not shout advice during the game. Let the coaches coach
- Do not harass or criticize the referee, the other team, or other players/parents.
- Do not compare the skill, courage, or attitudes of your children with other members of the team.
- Do not discuss game situations with the coach immediately after a game. 24-hour rule to discuss.
- Get to know the coach so that you can understand his/her philosophy, attitudes, ethics, and leadership style.
- Support the coach and his/her assistants with the things they are trying to accomplish.
- Try to sit with team's parents and cheer, cheer, cheer!
- Communication escalation: player→coach; player/parent→coach, player/parent→coach/director
