

**Golden Valley Little League
Major and Minor A Division Replacement Player Procedure**

Requesting Replacement Players for Majors and Minor A League

- Request is made by the Manager or designee.
- No replacement player is permitted to be used in a different division other than their assigned division.
- A request for a replacement player **may** only be made if you have nine rostered players.
- A request for a replacement player **must** be made if you have fewer than nine rostered players.
- The maximum number of rostered players a team may have including a replacement player is ten.
- Replacement player cannot pitch.
- Replacement player must be placed at the bottom of the batting order at game time.
- A single replacement player that is the tenth roster player must play a minimum and maximum of nine consecutive defensive outs and one at bat.
- If more than one replacement player is requested to achieve ten rostered players then each replacement shall play a minimum of nine consecutive defensive outs and one at bat.
- No replacement player is permitted to play more than a rostered team player.
- *Minimum play of nine consecutive defensive outs and one at bat is a Little League International rule.*

How to request a replacement player.

- At the point the need for a replacement player is identified you will contact the designated person for the appropriate division. See below
- Majors
 1. Player Agent
 2. Vice President
- Minor A
 1. Minor A Coordinator
 2. Vice President
- Once the request is made a player will be assigned.
- Managers are not permitted to request a specific player.
