Hold Harmless/Medical Information/Forms

All your forms were completed when you registered for camp so nothing else is needed.

REGISTRATION AND CHECK IN:

You will check in on Sunday June 7th between 1:00pm – 2:00pm in the lobby of the Perry Fieldhouse located at 801 N. Mercer Rd. on the campus of BGSU (about 500 feet from the Slater Family Ice Arena).

HOUSING AND MEALS:

You will be housed in a dormitory located near the ice arena. You will be responsible for providing your own bed linens, blankets, pillow, towels etc... Because the dormitory is air-conditioned, it is important to bring a blanket. A sleeping bag is an alternative. We recommend that you limit any electronic devices you bring with you. If you bring a cell phone or electronic device, they must remain in your dorm room at all times. The BG Hockey School is not responsible for lost or damaged appliances or any type of electronic devices.

Because this is a USA Hockey sponsored camp, you will be assigned a roommate randomly.

CAMP OVERVIEW:

- Players will be placed onto four teams
 - Players will find out their team assignments when they check in
 - Goalies will be on a revolving schedule, so they get to practice and play against all teams.

- Main purpose of the camp is to evaluate the talent and move players on to one of the following:
 - National Camp in Amherst, NY July 15-21 for all players
 - Goalies: July 13 – 15 then 15-21 with rest of the players.
- Two or three ice sessions per day
- Daily lecture (NCAA eligibility, Strength Training, Nutrition are the scheduled talks)
- All players will have individual face to face evaluations with members of the coaching staff on Wednesday afternoon/evening
