

THE NEIGHBORHOOD REWARD PROGRAM

Help fund your lacrosse expenses with your grocery and gas dollars and help the Grandview Lacrosse Booster Club raise funds for the Grandview Lacrosse program - without any effort or cost to you. Participate in the King Soopers Neighborhood Reward Program.

First purchase a King Soopers card for everyone who would like to help: **family members, aunts and uncles, grandparents, friends, neighbors**. They cost \$5.00 each and have a \$5.00 balance, making them cost-free to you. Then when you next go to King Soopers, you can “reload” the card with any amount up to \$500 at the service desk or the cashier. This must be done as a separate transaction prior to your groceries being scanned. When you check out, use your King Soopers card to pay just like a debit or credit card.

You can **use your King Soopers card to pay for fuel at King Soopers or City Market fuel centers**. **Don't forget out-of-state friends and family**. The cards can be used at most Kroger affiliated stores throughout the US. These include:



Unlike most gift cards, the King Soopers gift card can be reloaded; you don't have to buy a new card. And be careful not to lose it. **Lost cards cannot be replaced or balances reimbursed.**

About once a month King Soopers mails a check to the Booster Club for 5% of the total loaded for that month. The entire 5% goes into an account that is yours to use to pay for lacrosse season fees and other expenses. All KSA fund requests must be for charges that benefit the player.

Small print (Yeah, there's always small print):

You can purchase everything **EXCEPT SERVICES** such as:

- Western Union
- Money Orders
- Tickets West
- Postage Stamps
- Lottery Tickets
- Other gift cards

King Soopers sends us a check about once a month if the total added to cards sold by the club is \$5,000 or more. If the total should be less than that, the amount is carried over to the next month until the minimum total of \$5,000 is met.

The club cannot determine your account balance in real time. We receive a monthly statement along with the check. We can only know the balance as of the last statement we have received and can make funds available only after we have received the statement and check from King Soopers.

You can find the current balance on each card to determine if you need to reload it in one of four ways:

1. The balance will be printed on your cash register receipt.
2. Visit www.gcbalance.com.
3. Call 866-822-6252
4. You can ask your cashier to check for you.

For numbers 2 and 3, you will need your card number and the pin which can be found on the back of the card when you scratch off "Kroger."

You must reload your card **before** the cashier starts ringing up your purchases.

Cards with a zero balance for 90 days will become inactive. But you can buy another \$5.00 card at any time

How to Use Funds in Your KSA Account

Contact the KSA Coordinator to determine the balance of your KSA account as of the last statement. Under the **Home>Fundraising** tab on the web site (www.grandviewlacrosse.com) click on **Request for Use of KSA Funds**. This is a word document you can save to your computer. Fill in the requested information on this form, and e-mail to the KSA Coordinator with a subject of **Request for Use of KSA Funds**. That's it!

- To use KSA funds- families must have one or more lacrosse player(s) enrolled at GVHS.
- KSA funds may only be used to pay for GVHS lacrosse player's expenses. Funds may not be used for the benefit of family members and/or gifted to another player/family.
- Player expense requests may be a combination of KSA funds and additional money from a check or cash. Checks need to arrive in the PO box by closure of the registration date and cash should be delivered directly to club Treasurer. Credit cards may not be used in conjunction with KSA payments.
- For families of graduated players with younger brothers (not yet in high school) who plan to play lax for GVHS, the KSA account can remain open and accrue funds for future use. Should the younger player not enroll at GV as a freshman, the KSA balance will be forfeited and transferred to Booster Club.
- Any KSA balance of graduated players (without younger brothers) will be forfeited and transferred to Booster Club.
- **Please always include "KSA" in the subject line of any e-mails. This makes it much easier to find and organize any correspondence.**
