



Company Audition Information

The Endeavor Dance Company season begins September 2nd, 2025, and continues through July 21st, 2026. Please review all team expectations & requirements before auditioning. Dancers interested in auditioning for one of our competitive teams must attend the Audition Week August 12th-16th. Dancers interested in our Mini, Petite, and Performing Groups do not need to audition.

Audition Info Meeting (August 6th @ 6:00pm)

We will hold an informational meeting on August 8th at 6:00pm for all new dancers to answer any questions regarding auditions, company requirements, etc. All parents/dancers are encouraged to attend. Returning company members are not required to attend.

Audition Intensive Week Information (August 11th-15th)

August 11th-13th Audition Workshop

Dancers will work on a variety of technical elements with our Endeavor staff during the first portion of the morning. During the second half, dancers will focus on learning two combinations: one jazz and one contemporary. Teachers will be giving cleaning notes to see which dancers can make the suggested adjustments.

August 14th Audition Evaluation & Placement

Dancers will be asked to perform their practiced technical elements and combinations for the Endeavor staff. Dancers will be evaluated based on progress, consistency, and performance. Some dancers may be asked to attend more than one session.

August 15th Final Audition

Dancers will be asked to perform their practiced technical elements and combinations for a panel of random judges. This day simulates a competition performance. Judges will be looking to see what the dancers can bring to the performance floor. Judges scores will be used to calculate audition results. Dancers will audition in groups of 6 beginning at 12:00pm with our youngest dancers and will progress by age. Dancers will receive a designated 20 minute time block for their final audition.

Other Notes

- Dancers should audition by their “competition age” – this is your age as of January 1st, 2026.
- Dancers must attend all intensive days in order to audition.
- Dancers must have completed 30 hours (Beginning & Intermediate dancers) or 40 hours (Advanced dancers) of summer training before auditioning. Summer training logs are available on our website and should be turned in with your audition application.
- Accounts must be up to date or dancers will not be allowed to audition.
- Parents and dancers must read and accept all Team Requirements before auditioning.
- Audition results will be posted on our website under Team Information on Saturday, August 16th at 12:00pm.
- Any dancers that are not selected for the company will be invited to join the Performing Group team.
