Our focus this year was to grow from the ground up. Our houseleague program feeds our rep program.

We had 2 soft lax teams and sourced jerseys instead of t-shirts. This was a huge hit for the parents and players.

What does this mean for 2020 if we can't retain our players, we won't have an association.

We ran the paperweight program as a 3 on 3 program with zero contact. We had 26 players register after our first weekend via word of mouth and the fact that we didn't have contact.

We piloted an interlock program with Oshawa and Clarington, it was successful and we will continue running this.

Champ day was a one day format. If registration improves, we can revisit a 2-day tournament style again.

- No drama almost uniformly positive feedback
- From Zero to Two [Refs] in 23 minutes

The Bad (The Challenges):

- Refs not scheduled for 1 HL game ... scheduling confusion
- Reduced Entry Level Refs but Reduced # of Games
- 7 yes 7 overtimes! LAX needs shootouts (if only for tournaments)

The Ugly:

- 2018 saw a 50% reduction of HL games vis-à-vis 2017, which was 46% of 2016.
- ➤ House League Interlock is a critical element going forward. Simplifies age groups & minimizes size disparities.
- Continued use of centralized Rep Game Assignments
- Improved association RIC feedback loop. Allows small centre Refs to get experience not otherwise available to them.
- > Return of the Women's Tournament (aka Chicks With Sticks)
- Cooperation, Cooperation, Cooperation going forward

Sonya Crossey thanked the board for all the hard work that they did this season. One of the things that you need to remember is that it isn't a popularity contest.
