MISSION

The New Richmond Basketball Association has established a financial assistance “club” to provide assistance to players’ families that have run into financial hardship. This “club” has the intent to keep kids playing the game of basketball rather than be forced out by the hardship.

FUNDING

The NRBA Board of Directors will determine through the annual budget process the dollar amount to be allocated for the financial assistance fund. It is also the intention of NRBA that each year a % of donated funds to the NRBA will be allocated to this fund.

The NRBA Board of Directors will establish the Financial Assistance Committee (FAC) which will be authorized to award assistance based on availability of those allocated funds. The FAC will consist of the NRBA President, Treasurer and two current board members.

Levels of assistance will vary from year to year based on funds available and any donated funds. All financial awards will be applied as a credit to the player’s registration fees and not in cash. Partial or full awards may be granted; however, in no case will the financial award amount exceed the current year’s registration fee. If player is attempting to participate in the traveling program the tryout fee will NOT be waived and must be paid even if assistance is awarded. **If you are granted a scholarship, you will be required to fulfill certain volunteer requirements, up and above the yearly team requirements as determined by the NRBA Board of Directors.**

Applicants must be current NRBA members in good standing and age appropriate to be eligible to participate based on rules that govern the NRBA.

APPROVAL PROCESS

Factors for approval will include but are not limited to:

1. Demonstrated financial need
2. Availability of funds
3. Completed financial assistance form
4. Participant commitment to practices and games
5. Volunteer commitment and mandatory participation in any fundraising activities
6. Player and family showing willingness to conduct themselves in an exemplary manner consistent with the ideals, rules, and standards of the New Richmond Basketball Association



PROCEDURES

Send completed forms to the NRBA Treasurer by September 1st of the year in which the player chooses to apply the potential award.

Exceptions may be reviewed on a case-by-case basis however; because a limited amount of funding is available, the NRBA strongly suggests that you submit your application prior to the deadline.

After the August 1st deadline the Treasurer will review the forms and may verify financial information submitted. Applications will be numbered in the order they are received and the applicant's name will be removed. The Treasurer will then submit the application paperwork to the FAC for review and approval. The Treasurer will be a non-voting member and act in an advisory capacity. The FAC will meet in a closed and confidential session, not at a public monthly meeting, to make their selections based on application information and guidelines established by the NRBC Board of Directors. Applicants will be notified by the Treasurer with the results within 24 hours of final decision.
