D. MSHSL updates and information - Erich Martens - MSHSL Executive Director. Membership important to provide access for all kids, all activities important. MSHSL "state actor." Guidance 10% from MSHSL, 90% from individual organizations. Met in person last week, getting schedules set. Administrative regions set by enrollment. Sections- we live with uneven numbers. Two things up for consideration before the Representative Assembly May 11, 2021: Boys Volleyball and Girls Wrestling. Finance Advisory Committee has met, setting member dues for next year. 4.5 million projected for Dues revenue (4.75 million last year). Recognition highlights: Kylin Runninghawk National level award winner Heart of the Arts and Official Jimmy Robinson. Work continues on masks, testing and vaccinations. Hopeful for testing/vaccinations as alternatives to wearing masks. We have work to do on Diversity and Inclusion. Working on the Website.

E. Introductions of Executive Director/Asst to Director, Board, new delegates and new sports association officers. The following Sports associations were not represented: Adapted, B. Basketball, Dance, Gymnastics, G. Hockey, B. Lacrosse, Nordic Ski, Synchronized Swim, Wrestling.

F. MSHSL Board of Directors Report: Dawn Engebretson (Rockford)/John Vraa (New London-Spicer). Summer coaching waiver pushed back one week to June 7- July 31, 2021. Overall, State tournaments were successful w/webcasting. Non compliance with mask wearing- schools who did not comply were served notice and need to respond. Currently, mask free except in transition areas (locker rooms, dug-out, bus, etc). "Our School" website- coaches can see schedules, enter rosters/results. Encourage coaches to download the Our School App. Coaches educational offerings on line. Tournament modifications being worked on.

G. Executive Directors Report-Rick Ringeisen (Lakeville).

1. Approval of March 2020 Minutes. Motion was made to approve March 2020 Minutes by Tavia Bachman, 2nd by Mike Lhotka. Motion passed unanimously.
2. Membership Report (page 4). 3 year comparison. Biggest change was Spring 2020 down

703 members. Expect to rebound.

3. Financial Report- Nathan Youngs (Dassel-Cokato)/ Thomas Sharp (Eastview)

Second Draw PPP Loan: \$8,750.00 Origination date: 1/28/2021. Major changes due to covid (no clinics- reduced expenses). Large donation (\$20,200 from Jerry Raddatz). Ron & Jerry story, Prep coach. Plan on increasing Coaches Caring checks from \$100 to \$200. We currently have a healthy account balance. Motion was made to approve the Finance report by Terry Sadler, 2nd by Jim Baker. Motion passed unanimously

4. NOCAD Update-Rick Ringeisen. We received a rebate from the Insurance company. Many Sports Associations across the country are working on Diversity and Inclusion.

5. Update on court case/appeal. Slander case is delayed due to pandemic, defendant filed bankruptcy. We are supportive of this coach, we need to set a precedent.

6. Membership Issues. Working on a Digital card.

K. Hall of Fame Banquet and Hall of Fame Report - Bernie Schumacher/Chair (Park Rapids) No banquet in 2020. Winners from 2020 will be recognized this year. Increased ticket price to \$45 this year.

L. Distinguished Service Award for Officials – Mike Peterson. Unique award- they are very appreciative. So far 21 nominees- we could use more. Please send in.

Tom Sharp- we do not recognize assistants enough. 2 yrs ago we started to recognize Assistant coaches. Go to website or Prep Coach for Nomination forms

M. Updates Each Sport Association- Each sport is asked to give a brief update about their issues, concerns, and initiatives. **Girls Swim & Dive** Kelly Boston -Had Sections, no State or banquet. Virtual Clinics on Website. **Golf** Ben Jergens- Working on Transition to President. **Robotics** Becky Leuer- Pandemic actually helped with the pause. Now have 8 section reps. **Soccer** Ben LeVahn- Had Sections, no State tournament. Working on new section alignment. Plan in person Clinic this fall. **Cross Country** Brandon Heebink- Had Section meets, no State, but had “end of season” meet. Working on the shift from 2 to 3 class. Had Virtual banquet. **Tennis** David Wareham-Had Virtual Clinic. Rick Englestad is leaving- David is transitioning to executive secretary, Rob Decorsey new President. Tennis tournament will mirror what Wrestling had. **Girls Lacrosse** Sarah Roth- Numbers of teams are consistent but member numbers on teams are down. Hoping on MDH recommendations regarding masks. **Girls Basketball** Brad Strand- recognized state leagues doing a good job. AllStar game next week. Had Virtual Clinic last fall, hoping for

in-person Clinic in October. Thank you to MSHSCA. After coaching 31 years going to Superintendent position at Breckinridge. Leah Dasovich will take over this position. **Alpine Ski** Nathan Springer- Had a great year, did have State tournament. Trying to get Alpine Board more active with coaches, get coaches enrollment backup and offer more education. Had a number of Zoom meetings. Trying to get equity for athletes. **Boys Hockey** Mike Taylor- First year President. Had a shortened but successful season. Plan in person Clinic in the fall. Association has been very active through Zoom. **Football** Ron Stolski- Kudos to Rob Nielsen, website. Edited mission statement for the FB association to support/promote diversity. Developed Youth Football position statement. Had Virtual Clinic with 1200 coaches/participants. June 26 All Star game. **Baseball** Craig Anderson-excited to have a season. Working on pitch count issues. State tournament dates are set, working on sites. Had a Virtual Clinic in Jan and hoping for 2 day in-person Clinic and banquet in Nov. Jerry Raddatz donated. Supportive of Boys Volleyball but have concerns about it being a spring sport. **MNIAAA** Matt Mattson- new President position. Will expand the Executive Board from 4 to 6 members which will always include a woman and a person of color to help serve those unrepresented athletes. **Volleyball** Darrin Swanson- last season was cut short, no playoffs. Working on tournament sites. No in person Clinic last year or this year- may move it to spring. **Track & Field** Aaron Berndt- Would like to recognize Jody Redman she has helped out to get kids into meets and have a season. Final year of 2 class structure-excited to see 3 class. Biggest concern is potential adding Boys Volleyball to spring sports- problem with indoor space. Support Boys VB just not in spring. Started an Anti racism anti hate group modeled after what the Big 10 has done. Also 5 years ago started Women for Women Organization focusing on women in Track & Field. Meghan Orgeman spoke- this is a network that supports women, provides leadership and professional growth. **Sports medicine** Tom Sharp- Spring meeting last week. Current topic mask mandate, awaiting MDH approval (they are following clusters in youth sports). We are a recommendation body not a legislative body. Working on uniform health questionnaires including mental health questions. **Gordy Klomps**- Thanked Craig (Anderson) and Jerry (Raddatz) for all they have done for Baseball. He would like to be the at large photographer for the HOF banquet in the fall. **Softball** James Wajer - Shelly Hotzler stepping down. Working on State tournament. Need consistency between schools for mask enforcement.
