### GAME FORMAT

Two (2) 20-minute run time periods, with a horn every two minutes for shift changes.

2-minute rest between periods on the bench.

Intermediate Nets to be used for 8U Girls, with Goalies.

Mini Nets to be used for Mighty Mite, **without** Goalies

Team Play will be decided by the coaches of the teams playing based on the numbers each team has:

3 skaters (3v3) OR 4 skaters (4v4) OR 5 skaters (5x5)

All the scoring team players must be tagged up at the same time before any attacking player enters the zone.

When the goalie freezes the puck all players from the offensive team must leave the offensive zone and tag up on the "tag up" line.

Ice will be resurfaced after every two games at all levels.

No score will be kept or displayed on the scoreboard.

Goalies (8U): Required to have fully equipped goalies. Goalies may not be pulled at any time during the game.

Each team will provide one on-ice coach to officiate; no additional officials will be on-ice.
