

COVID-19 2020 Player Policies



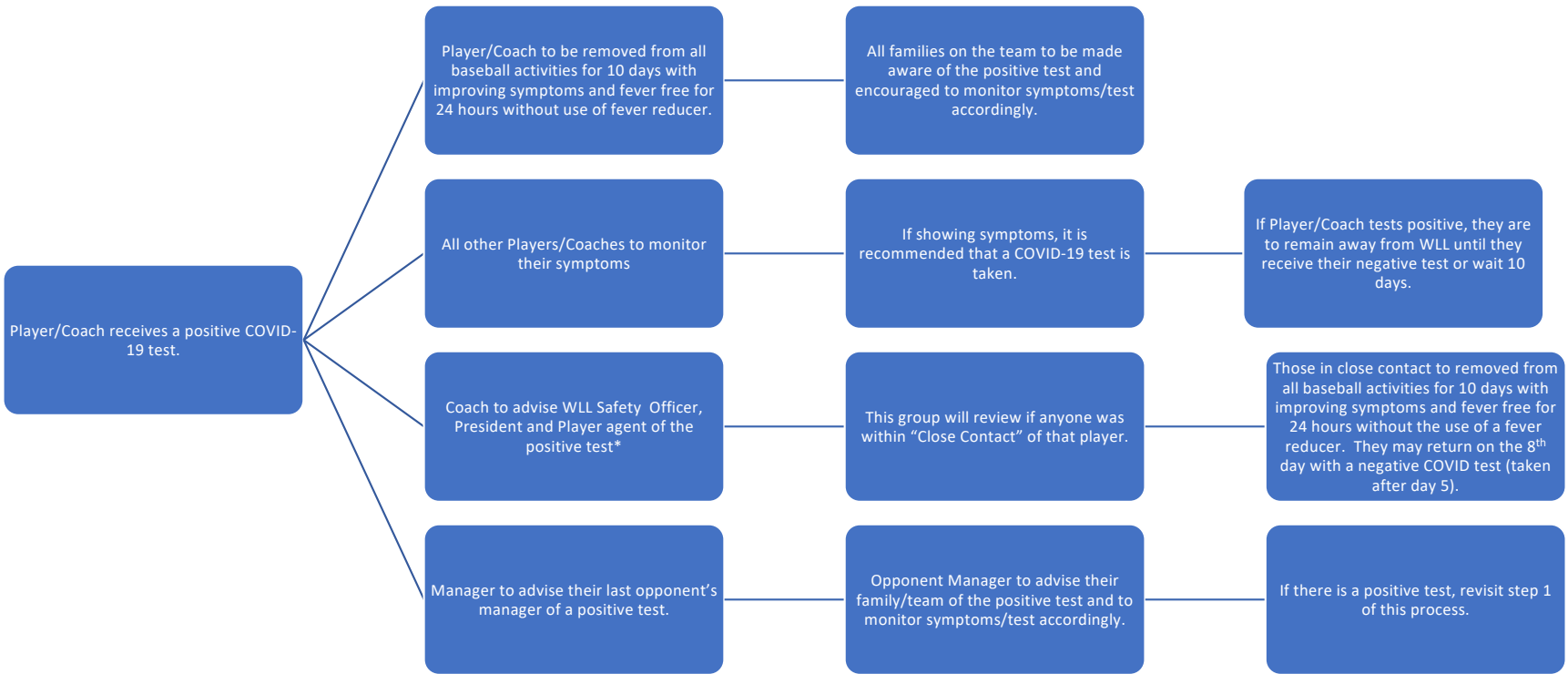
- Anyone with symptoms of fever, cough, or worsening respiratory symptoms should stay home.
- If your child is under quarantine from school due to "presumed positive" your child may not participate until the case is cleared (negative test).
- If your child is under quarantine from school due to "confirmed positive", they may not participate until after 10 days (no test) or on day 8 (with a negative test after day 5).
- If a COVID-19 test is pending for your child or household family member, your child may not participate until the results of those test are received.
- If your child was in **close contact** with someone who has COVID-19, they are to be removed all baseball activities for 10 days with improving symptoms and fever free for 24 hours without the use of a fever reducer. They may return on the 8th day with a negative COVID test (taken after day 5).
 - What counts as **close contact**?
 - You were within 6 feet of someone who has COVID-19 for a total of 15 minutes or more
 - You provided care at home to someone who is sick with COVID-19
 - You had direct physical contact with the person (hugged or kissed them)
 - You shared eating or drinking utensils
 - They sneezed, coughed, or somehow got respiratory droplets on you

COVID-19 2020 Facility Policies



- Social distancing of 6 feet to be practiced by all coaches, players and spectators.
- Spectators of practice and/or games, are **required** to wear face coverings.
- Dugouts will not be used during practice. During games, 4 players will be allowed to be on the bench.
- Siblings should remain with their guardian and abstain from playing any group games.
- Players are permitted (not required) to wear a face covering on the field during game play.
- Face coverings will be required by coaches when in the dugout.
- All coaches, players and spectators should bring their own hand sanitizer. Additional hand sanitizer will be made available by the league.
- All individuals should bring their own personal drinks/snacks to all team activities. Drinks should be labeled with the person's name.
- Players should use and maintain their own equipment (bat/glove/batting helmets).
- If catchers gear is shared it must be cleaned/sanitized in between each use.
- All umpires are **required** to wear a face covering.

COVID-19 Close Contact 2020 Action Plan



Household member or close contact tests positive for COVID-19

Individual be removed from all baseball activities for 10 days with improving symptoms and fever free for 24 hours without the use of fever reducer. They may return on the 8th day with a negative COVID test (taken after day 5).

If anyone qualifies as a close contact and was recently engaged with the team, all families on the team to be made aware of the positive test and encouraged to monitor symptoms/test accordingly.

* **Close Contact is defined as someone who was within 6 feet of an infected person for a cumulative total of 15 minutes or more over a 24-hour period**
