He currently serves as an assistant goalie coach with Goalies House in Cupertino and works as a youth hockey coach at Sharks Ice, bringing strong technical knowledge and a passion for goalie development.

**Lead Strength & Conditioning Coach | *Shane Galaviz*** | Currently the Jr. Sharks Director of Strength & Conditioning, he is a certified strength and conditioning specialist and former assistant strength coach for the Anaheim Ducks. Most recently, he also served as Head Coach of the Jr. Sharks 12AAA Girls and 12BB teams, bringing a high-performance training background to player development on and off the ice.
