HIGH SCHOOL WRESTLING

A high school wrestling bout consists of three periods of two minutes each; the first period starts with both contestants on their feet, while the second and third periods start with the boys on the mat with each being given one turn to start on top in the "control" position.

The objective of amateur wrestling is to CONTROL THE OPPONENT, and if possible to hold his shoulders to the mat for two seconds, which is the highest degree of control; this known as a fall or a pin and terminates the bout. If neither contestant is able to win a fall, a decision will be awarded, based upon the maneuvers the wrestlers were able to execute in gaining control, keeping control and attempting to win a fall; these maneuvers are scored as follows:

TAKEDOWN	2 points
(Take opponent off his feet and to the mat)	
ESCAPE	1 point
(Escape from below to neutral position)	
REVERSAL	2 points
(Escape and go on top in one movement)	
NEAR FALL	2 points
(Nearly win a fall)	
PREDICAMENT	1 point
(Nearly win a "near fall")	
TIME IN CONTROL POSITION	1 or 2 points
(The time each boy is in control is recorded by the timers; at the end of the bout "net" time in control is computed and scored at 1 point per full minute)
