The ADM/ Player development team met initially to create an online training program for our players and coaches during this unprecedented time in our country. Our team has done a great job with short notice to accomplish this task. Wes Bolin, Brooke White, Guy Gosselin, Steve Carroll, Mike Terwilliger, Mike MacMillan, Jacob Mars, Steve Oleheiser, Glen Andresen and Dave Margenau have worked diligently putting these programs together. We now have 6 weeks of training on the website for players at the 6U/8U, 10U/12U, and 15U/16U levels of play. These items are still on the web site to use and can be used in the future when to get back to our regular season for 2021-22. It would also be a focus for the team to enhance these programs so our players can look to ideas for dryland training on the web site.
