Updates on:

6. Winter/Spring Sports Masses

4. New Sport Opportunity

5. Baseball/Softball/Track/Boys volleyball registration dates

- g. Girls softball: Rosters need to be finalized by mid-January. Season starts the first week of April. Pre season tournament at St I's the last week of March. Post season tournament at St I's on 7th and 8th.
