

## 2016 Scholarship Recipients

We are proud to announce the winners of the 2016 scholarships:

**Flora Davis** competed with the Rain City Flyers cross country team from 2008-2014. In 2008 she was a member of the 9-10 girls team that finished second at the Junior Olympics National Championships in Richmond, Virginia. Flora continued to compete in cross country and track at Roosevelt HS. She was a 4 year letter winner in cross country and captain of both the cross country and track teams.
