



# **Panther Hockey Safety Guidelines**

Our region has recently been moved to Phase IV. This change will allow game play. However, it does not mean an end to the safety protocols that are in place. Please read this document. These rules apply to everyone. We need everyone's support to be able to keep the kids playing.

**#1**

## **All Individuals Entering the Ice Arena Must:**

- Wear a mask/face covering properly over the nose & mouth. These are required to be worn while on the ice as well.
- Maintain social distance.



## **Panther Hockey Game/Scrimmage Protocols**

### ***In addition to #1 above...***

- Player should arrive no more than 10 minutes prior to ice time (exception to goalies).
- Locker rooms will be made available 10 minutes prior to ice time and 10 minutes after ice time. Plan accordingly. Arriving fully dressed is strongly recommended. You will only have 10 minutes to put on any gear & tie skates if not arriving fully dressed. NO lobby/restroom changing.
- Only 3 coaches are allowed on each bench.
- Only 2 people are allowed in the scoreboard/penalty box area.
- On game days, ONE parent/guardian per skater is allowed to stay inside & watch. NO siblings.
- Spectators must sit socially distanced in the bleachers.
- No viewing from the lobby area.
- Once game/scrimmage is over, skaters & spectators must exit the building using the North exit doors, under the bleachers near the locker rooms. Do not go back thru the lobby.
- Each team is responsible for the conduct of its spectators.
- Anyone not following these rules will be asked to leave.
- All games/scrimmages must be approved by the hockey director.
