E3 Volleyball, through the E3 Tiger Memorial Fund, aims to provide all players the opportunity to reach their full athletic potential in volleyball while promoting leadership, teamwork, friendship, character, goal setting, and self-discipline.

By signing below, you acknowledge and agree to the following terms:

- Tiger Memorial Scholarship grants will only be issued to players who have applied **August 30, 2025** and have demonstrated financial need.
- Tiger Memorial Scholarship grant money is distributed based on available funds and the number of qualified families applying **August 30, 2025**
 - THEREFORE, THERE IS NO GUARANTEE THAT YOUR PLAYER WILL RECEIVE FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE.
 - FAMILIES SHOULD NEVER EXPECT TO RECEIVE MORE THAN **10% OF THE ANNUAL DUES** IN THE FORM OF A TIGER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP GRANT.
- Families requiring additional assistance should be prepared to actively participate in the work program.
- Due to limited funds, applications should only be submitted if playing for E3 Volleyball presents a financial hardship.
- Alternate payment plans are available; please contact the Accounting Department via email at infoE3VB@gmail.com for details.
- Players with past due payments will be ineligible for Tiger Memorial Scholarship grants until their account is current.
- If there is a balance owed from a prior season, the family must pay it in full before applying. Failure to do so by the application deadline will forfeit eligibility for the Tiger Memorial Scholarship grant, though funds may still be earned through the work program.
- Tiger Memorial Scholarship grant funds have **no monetary value**:
 - Any credit resulting from Tiger Memorial Scholarship funds will be returned to the scholarship fund for redistribution.
 - If the player's account is paid in full at the time the Scholarship Committee meets August 30, 2025, the player will not be eligible for a Tiger Memorial Scholarship grant, as there is no outstanding balance.
 - It is the family's responsibility to contact the Accounting Department before August 30, 2025 if an extension of the final invoice due date to August 30, 2025 is needed to maintain an outstanding balance eligible for a Tiger Memorial Scholarship grant application.
- Disbursed Tiger Memorial Scholarship funds will be applied to the oldest outstanding invoice first until exhausted.
- Monthly dues must still be paid in full by the due date each month.

We understand the financial responsibility of club volleyball and are committed to working with families as much as possible without disadvantaging other players. If your financial situation changes during the season, please keep the Accounting Department updated so we can support your family's circumstances.
