



SPRING GAME DAY RESPONSIBILITIES



The following are general rules and expectations that are in place for Aztec Soccer Club and its visitors (league competitions, trainings, scrimmages, friendlies, etc.) per the guidance of local health and public officials. We greatly appreciate your assistance in helping to keep us all safe and our players on the field.



Playing Status

- * All participants and visitors should make themselves familiar with the current guidelines provided by Massachusetts and New Hampshire and set in place by Aztec Soccer Club.

- * There are currently no game modifications in effect for Aztec competitions. It is important to note that there will always remain an inherent risk participating in sports and any modifications are designed to minimize the risk of transmission of infection among participants.



Five Key Responsibilities

1

DAILY HEALTH ATTESTATION: Every player who takes part in a league event is responsible for conducting a personal health assessment. If a player is not able to attest to full health, they are not to report to any club or league event.

MASK & FACE COVERING: Players and coaches are required to have a facial covering with them at all times and to follow the stated rules for when wearing a face covering is required. Parents/guardians must have a facial covering with them at all times and adhere to the mask wearing policies set forth by all facilities & clubs.

HAND SANITIZER: Every player should have personal hand sanitizer with them at all times and should apply hand sanitizer on a regular basis including but not limited to before and after every game session.

MAINTAIN SOCIAL DISTANCING: Players, coaches and parents should remain socially distanced (6 ft apart) as much as possible when attending league events.

STAY HOME IF UNWELL: If a player, coach or spectator is not feeling well and is exhibiting signs of Covid-19, they are instructed to stay home and not attend any club or league events.



Pre-Arrival Guidelines

- * Parents must ensure their players' health. If the temperature is over 100.5 degrees, the player is not permitted to attend an Aztec or league event. The player must be 24 hours temperature free prior to competing. Players should also attest to not having any of the following symptoms (per the CDC "This list does not include all possible symptoms and symptoms may appear 2-14 days after exposure to the virus.")
 - * Fever or Chills, Cough, Shortness of Breath or Difficulty Breathing, Fatigue, Muscle or Body Aches, Headache, New Loss of Taste or Smell, Sore Throat, Congestion or Runny Nose, Nausea or Vomiting, Diarrhea.
 - * Players must also attest that they have not been in close contact with anyone confirmed to have Coronavirus (Covid-19) in the past 14 days.
- * Before entering the game day fields, players are required to apply hand sanitizer. (personally supplied).
- * Players will ONLY be allowed to enter the game day fields using the designated entrance.



Game Day Protocols

- * Players, coaches and spectators must always adhere to the stated facility rules and follow all state and local health protocols. They are also required to review and adhere to the guidelines and protocols made to comply with the respective state guidelines pertaining to capacity, facial coverings, protective equipment, transportation, and out-of-state travel.
- * Aztec has established the following guidelines that are in place for all home matches.
 - * Players, coaches and spectators should enter the field only through the clearly marked and designated entrance and exit points at each location.
 - * Incoming teams may not enter a field until the previous teams have left the field unless there is a designated warm-up space that allows for proper distance from other on-site teams. We ask that teams quickly leave the field of play at the conclusion of their game.
 - * Aztec will provide all game balls which will be disinfected immediately prior to the first and second half of play by staff members.
 - * Coaches and players should attempt to socially distance as much as possible while on the sidelines.



Spectator Guidelines

- * For competitive matches, spectators will be allowed so long as social distancing is possible. At all times there must be adequate space for all players, coaches, referees, facility/activity workers and spectators to maintain at least six feet social distancing.
- * All staff, volunteers, and visitors should bring to sporting events and wear, reusable/washable cloth face coverings over their nose and mouth as mandated by respective state law.
- * Facility protocols take precedence over any league and club guidelines.
