Tami called the meeting to order at 7:00pm.

1. Minutes: Rochelle made a motion to approve the March 16, 2017 meeting minutes. Bill seconded. Motion passed.
2. Director's Report: Erin and Brad were not present at this meeting. A couple of notes from them: We have approximately 18 students signed up for color guard. This will likely impact our budget. Also, due to the addition of more marchers this coming fall, the directors are working on figuring out instrumentation.
3. Treasurer's Report: Rochelle-We have \$34,403.92 in our account which is broken down into scholarships, trips, general funds, and marching band.
4. Tiger Fan Club Report: Sue D.
 - a. Fundraising-Continuing plans to hold a pull tab fundraiser.
 - b. Raffles-Because raffles are a form a gambling, booster clubs are not allowed to hold any raffles until the process of getting a gambling license is complete.
 - c. Concessions Fulfillment-Prior to the football season, booster groups will claim volunteer slots. The band gets dibs on working concessions during the football games along with the football booster club.
 - d. Parking lots will be resurfaced this summer. This may affect the marching band season.
5. Marching Band Updates:
 - a. Parent Meeting is scheduled for May 10th at 6:30pm in the large lecture hall. A variety of items (tumblers, decals, pillows) will be for sale along with a display of the new apparel.
 - b. Uniform Fitting-Rochelle will start fitting students over finals week.
 - c. MB Essentials-Parents and students will be able to purchase the essentials they need for the marching band season by clicking on the MB Essentials link which can be found on our website www.farmingtontigerbands.org.
 - d. Props-Dean will be setting up a meeting with the band directors and operations director to get things started.
 - e. Parades-The Dew Days parade will be our first parade with our new uniforms. It is anticipated that more than an average amount of volunteers will be needed.

6. Fundraising:
 - a. Bachman's flower sale: Beth-Sale ends on Thursday, April 27th. Volunteers will be collecting order forms that evening. May 10th is the date for pickup from 3-6pm.
 - b. Tumblers: Sandy-Tumblers will be available for sale at our parent meeting on May 10th. 100 each of 3 designs were ordered. Price is \$10 each. May 2nd is the projected delivery date.
 - c. Amazon Smile: A portion of the money spent on Amazon for certain items will go back to the band program. Go to smile.amazon.com and select Farmington band.
 - d. Pillows: Rochelle-24 pillows were made from old uniforms and 51 more are in process. 4 have been sold. Any money made after 10 pillows are sold will be pure profit. Other items are being created from parts of the old uniforms and will be presented at the next band brunch.
 - e. Tiger Scramble: Dan-Fliers have been made (Thanks Ben!) and will be distributed for teams to start signing up. Sign up will take place on our website. The date has been set for July 28th. Dan plans to meet with Mike Gorden and Jon Holmes to continue working on plans.
