



## COVID-19 PROCEDURES

### ATTENDANCE TRACKING

All visiting teams are required to provide team game roster, no later than 24 hours prior to the start of the game.

### ARRIVING AT THE RINK

#### COACHES & SKATERS

Coaches & Skaters may enter the building 30 minutes prior to the start of the game. Once players enter the locker room, they are required to remain in the locker room until a coach releases them to take the ice. Parents of players 10U or younger can enter with the player to tie skates, but must exit the building immediately after (will be let back in with other parents at game time).

In compliance with WAHA COVID-19 Policies (extended until January 19<sup>th</sup>, 2021), **coaches and players are required to wear a mask on and off the ice.**

#### RESTROOM USAGE

If players must use the restroom, they should do so on the way to the locker room. Once they enter the locker room they must remain there until a coach releases them, no exceptions.

#### EXITING

Coaches and skaters will have 15 minutes to exit the building after the completion of the game. Players must remove gear and exit ASAP – no socializing, etc. after the event.

If players are unable to undress and exit the building within the 15 minutes it takes to resurface the ice, they will be held in the locker room until the skaters for the next game have taken the ice and all spectators are in the stands.

**It is important that the kids focus on exiting after the game so that we can ensure we don't have congestion between games entering/exiting the locker rooms or the building.**

#### SPECTATORS

Spectators will not be admitted until skaters are taking the ice, and must vacate the building immediately upon conclusion of the game.

As spectators enter the rink, the door volunteer will confirm which skater they are supporting (limit 2 per skater). The provided team game roster will be used for admittance into the hockey rink.

- Only two spectators per skater will be allowed in the building.
- The two spectators per skater can be of any age. Children under the age of 2 yrs. old will not count as one of the two spectators per skater limit. Children that do enter as spectators are expected to remain seated, and are not to be running around the rink or in the shooting corner, they should be seated next to their parent(s).
- **Social distancing and face coverings are required.**
- Parent volunteers, coaches, team managers/ reps do not count towards the two (2) spectator limit per skater.

As a reminder, proper social distancing and face covering requirements apply. Failure to observe these requirements will result in stoppage of play and/or removal of spectators for the remainder of the game.
