

Penguins Adult Hockey PASS & PUTT Tournament

June 17-19, 2022

- 3 Round-robin Hockey Games (3-on-3)
- 2 Rounds of 9-hole Golf (Scramble) with cart

Team fee: \$1560 (\$195 per player)

DETAILS:

- Upper C/B
- Middle C
- Lower C
- D

TEAM COMPOSITION:

7 Skaters plus Goalie – 8 players Total

- ❖ All participants must play in each hockey game and both golf scrambles

Hockey:

- ❖ All 7 Skaters must be able to play competently in the division your team is competing in
- ❖ All 7 skaters must play roughly equal amount of time

Golf:

- ❖ Each 4-some must use each player's drive from the tee box 2x per 9 holes from the White tees
- ❖ Each 4-some must use each player's putt total at least one time per 9 holes

FORMAT:

- ✓ Three Hockey Games:
 - Friday evening
 - Saturday morning/afternoon
 - Sunday morning/afternoon
- ✓ Games will be two, 20-minute halves.
- ✓ Players do not have to be USA Hockey members
- ✓ You do not have to be a current captain to enter a team
- ✓ Two Sets of 9-hole golf
- ✓ Scramble/Best Ball format
- ✓ Shotgun starts beginning at 5 pm on Saturday and Sunday

LOCATION:

Pheasant Ridge Golf Course

6065 Rittman Road

Gibsonia, PA 15044

There is a pavilion at the golf course for socializing after the round.

STRUCTURE:

Champions in each division will be determined by points acquired in the round-robin hockey games and the combined score of each team's two 4-somes in each round of golf.

Point Structure:

Hockey:

- Win 2 point
- Tie 1 point
- Loss Zero points

If teams are tied after the Round-robin games we will use our standard Adult League and Tournament Tie-breakers:

- Two teams tied in points.
- The tie-breakers will be:
 - Most wins
 - Head to Head
 - Goal differential
 - Fewest goals against
 - Most goals scored
 - Time stamp on registration (earliest team to register)
- Three or more teams tied = procedure will follow the above protocol, with the first goal to eliminate the lowest team and 'start over' with two teams.

Golf (per round):

- 1st place 4 points
- 2nd place 3 points
- 3rd place 2 points
- 4th place 1 point

If two teams in the same division are tied at the end of either day's round, the team that registered first will take the higher place.

- ✚ For example, two teams tied for second place on Saturday: Team A registered May 28th; Team B registered June 1st. Team A takes 2nd place; Team B takes 3rd place.
- ✚ This will also be the golf Tie-breaker if there are more than 2 teams tied at the end of any round within a division.

Golf points from Day 1 will be combined with those from Day 2 to arrive at a Golf Total.

- ✚ If there are ties after combining points for both days of golf, the date/time of registration will again be used

Golf Points will then be combined with Hockey points to arrive at a Champion in each division.

- ✚ If any teams are tied after combining points from golf and hockey, the registration date/time will again be used.
