

Mite/Termite Hockey Volunteer Requirements

This year, all mite/termite families will be required to work a total of 6 Dibs per player. Please remember that Dibs are depending on a shift, as a box worker at a tournament is 2 dibs while working the clock at a Saturday game may be 1. There will be several opportunities to work DIBS during the season at the events listed below. You may also work your DIBS at our GFYH tournaments. Available tournament opportunities will be e-mailed out to families once they are determined.. If you do not fill your DIBS requirements by the end of the season, you will be fined \$50 per 2 Dibs shifts. These fines are then used to pay to have the shifts covered by non-volunteers.

Volunteer exemptions.

Each mite/termite team will be allowed coaching volunteer waivers. Erik Fabien, the in house director, will provide a list of these names to me in early December and those given the waiver will be notified.
