## **COACH'S CORNER**

Coach Clark shared the following:

- Excited we are finally starting district
- Yes, we want to win all games but only 14 matter with our district opponents
- District is a whole new level of energy
- We have talked to guys about everyday being a tryout
- We have told all players that no matter what is going on with you and your playing time you have to be a teammate first and that will take away from playing time if you are not.
- We have a weekly plan rotation and keeping fresh
- Saturday practices will be on discretion of Coach
- Players are welcome in the dugout for the Varsity games
- We expect all players to be on the bus to and from the game. Email your Coach if you need to take players home from a game.
- Grades
  - The boys did a good job rebounding
  - Grades won't officially be in until Wed
  - Encourage you players to talk to and work with their teachers
  - There is a grade check every three weeks for eligibility
- District games are most heated and emotional
  - Please stick with the 24 hour rule if you would like to discuss anything with a Coach. Please keep in mind the night of the game is not a good time to approach the Coach.
  - Limited innings, limited opportunities – if you want to play you need to keep pushing
  - No time limit for Varsity and JV2 games
  - JV games are calibrated by Varsity games and can get cut short
- Coaches have an open door policy, we don't want misinformation or players being upset
  - Coach has time in the middle of the day if you need him
- Coach will email athletics to get the camera going (NAHS)
- Camp will be the first week after Memorial Day – tell anyone you know 4<sup>th</sup> – 6<sup>th</sup> grades morning and 7<sup>th</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> afternoon
